CHAPTER V

DISCUSSIONS

This chapter presents the result of data analysis that cover the description of the FTA and politeness strategies are performed in conversational fragments by among main characters in *Black Panther* movie based on Brown & Levinson theory of Politeness. The display of the data was done formerly by giving description of the context of the movie. It can help the readers to understand what will be provided by the researcher.

1. CF 1 00:07:32-00:08:20

- 1. O Coming up on them now.
- 2. BP No need, Okoye. I can handle this alone.
- **3. O** Hmm.
- 4. BP I will get Nakia out as quickly as possible.
- 5. O Just don't freeze when you see her.
- 6. BP What are you talking about? I never freeze.

Context:

Black Panther and Okoye found that a bunch of army cars in Sambisa Forest, Nigeria smuggle some people consist of women and children include Nakia through their technology of vibranium. Nakia is ex-girlfriend of Black Panther. That's why Okoye told Black Panther not to freeze when he see Nakia there. Okoye told Black Panther that they already near so that Black Panther can prepare himself to help the children and women. Okoye gave him a spear as a weapon to fight the soldiers but Black Panther refused.

Analysis:

Okoye said "Coming up on them now. (1.1)", this utterance is reminding sentence. In politeness theory, Okoye's utterance to Black Panther is negative face threatening act affecting the hearer's face. The S (Okoye) indicates that the H (Black Panther) should remember to do something by reminding Black Panther that the soldiers almost near with them. The politeness strategy in that sentence, "Coming up on the now" belongs to use baldly on record. it is because an urgency; the sentence contains information needs to be shared quickly so that Nakia does not reduce the threat to the H's face and moreover they are used in close relationship. BP replied by saying "No need, Okoye. I can handle this alone. (1.2)" and "I will get Nakia out as quickly as possible. (1.4)" These BP's utterances are his respond of Okoye's action taking him a spear as a weapon to fight the soldiers. In politeness theory, those utterances are negative face threatening act affecting the H's face containing strong (negative) emotion toward H e.g. lust. The S's lust indicates possible motivation for harming H's goods. BP said those lust sentences are to harm Okoye's worry to him and Nakia. Two both sentences used 'bald on record' politeness strategy. Black Panther try to say baldly because the situation is urgent; he wanted to save Nakia with all women and children. So, he said it without reduce the threat to the hearer's face. Okoye said to BP,

"Just don't freeze when you see her. (1.5)" This Okoye's utterance is warning sentence. In politeness theory, warning is included negative face threatening act affecting the H's face. Warning means the S indicates that he or someone will instigate sanctions unless the H does something for that. Okoye said that way to Black Panther in order that he can prepare well how to accost his ex-girlfriend there after long time no see. Okoye said this sentence to Black Panther using politeness strategy of 'bald on record' because of they are already in close relationship so that Nakia does not reduce threat to the H's face to do face threatening act. BP answered, "What are you talking about? I never freeze. (1.6)" This utterance is contradiction sentence. In Politeness theory, contradiction means the act threatens positive face the H's face. The S indicates that he thinks H is wrong is misguided or unreasonable about some issue, such a wrongness being associated with disapproval. BP refused Okoye's warning as he believed he would not freeze when meet Nakia. The politeness strategy BP used is bald on record. it indicates that he does not reduce the threat to the H's face to do FTA. Besides, they are in close relationship so no needed do something to reduce.

2. CF 2 00:10:57- 00:11:13

- 1. O You froze.
- 2. N Why are you here? You've ruined my mission.
- **3. BP** My father is dead, Nakia. I will be crowned king tomorrow. And I wish for you to be there.

Context:

At the last fight, Okoye came to help Black Panther. She saw Black Panther was freezing because of seeing Nakia. Black Panther with Okoye were succeed in releasing Nakia with all women and children. But in the other side, the smuggling actually can be handled by Nakia. It was her mission to let the soldiers bring them to go somewhere. So, Nakia felt disappointed Black Panther came to ruin her mission instead. Nakia ridiculed Black Panther and he showed her depreciation with his face telling her that his father is dead. He wants Nakia to come at the day when he will be crowned.

Analysis:

Okoye said to BP, "You froze. (2.1)" This Okoye's utterance aims to tease Black Panther after seeing Nakia there. In politeness theory, ridicule included positive face threatening act affecting the H's face. It shows the S has a negative evaluation of some aspect of H's positive face. It indicates Okoye does not like how Black Panther act freeze as he said that he would not do it. Okoye said it baldly because she no needs do something to reduce the threat to the H's face therefore they are in close social distance. Nakia said to BP, "Why are you here? You've ruined my mission. (2.2)" This Nakia's utterance to Black Panther is a reprimand sentence. In Politeness theory, same as ridicule, it shows the S does not like/

want one more H's wants, acts, personal characteristics, goods, beliefs or values. "Why are you here?" is an example how negative politeness is. Negative politeness is used as a way to interact in a non-imposing way, one of the situation is by using hedges or question. BP talked to Nakia, "My father is dead, Nakia. I will be crowned king tomorrow. And I wish for you to be there. (2.3)" The utterance "and I wish you to be there" is a request sentence. In Politeness theory, doing request belongs to negative face threatening act affecting the hearer's face. It indicates the S puts some pressure to H to do or refrain from doing some act A. Black Panther asked Nakia to come at the day he will be crowned. "and I wish you to be there" is an example the sentence using politeness strategy 'positive politeness'. Positive politeness is used as a way to make the hearer feel a sense of closeness and belonging. Also, positive politeness tends to avoid disagreement so the S tries to reduce the threat of the H's face by ordering sentence politely.

- 1. S Did he freeze?
- 2. O Like an antelope in headlights.
- **3. BP** Are you finished? So surprised my little sister came to see me off before our big day.
- **4. S** You wish! I'm here for the EMP beads. I've developed an update.
- 5. BP Update? No. It worked perfectly.
- 6. S How many times do I have to teach you? Just because something works doesn't mean that it cannot be improved.
- 7. BP You are teaching me? What do you know?
- 8. S More than you.

9. BP I can't wait to see what kind of update you make... to your ceremonial outfit.

Context:

At the next day, they (BP, Okoye, Nakia) arrived at Wakanda. Knowing the last incident in Sambisa forest, Shuri, BP's sister, she teased her brother about freezing in front of Nakia to Okoye. Shuri asked, "Did he freeze?" to Okoye. Okoye answered, "Like an antelope in headlights." Hearing that, BP reprimanded them, he said "are you finished?". This day is time BP will be crowned. He admired his sister will be dressed well for the event, he teased his sister by saying, "I can't wait to see what kind of update you make.. to your ceremonial outfit." Besides that, Shuri told him that she have developed an update. BP disagreed because it is already perfect of him. But, Shuri exactly reprimanded her brother by saying, "How many times do I have to teach you? Just because something works doesn't mean that it cannot be improved."

Analysis:

Shuri asked to Okoye, "Did he freeze? (3.1)" This sentence belongs to ridicule sentence. In Politeness theory, ridicule counted in positive face threatening act affecting the H's face. Shuri teased his brother because he freezed when meet his ex-girlfriend. The politeness strategy shuri used is bald on record. it is because she asked without any effort to reduce the threat to the H's face and

moreover they were in close relationship. Okoye answered Shuri bu saying, "Like an antelope in headlights. (3.2)" Okoye's answer for Nakia is belonging to ridicule sentence too for BP. In Politeness theory, ridicule indicates that the S has a negative evaluation of some aspect of H's positive face. Okoye did ridicule because of freezing by BP in front of Nakia. The politeness strategy she used is bald on record. She said it without any little or no desire to maintain the H's face. BP said, "Are you finished? So surprised my little sister came to see me off before our big day. (3.3)" Hearing Shuri and Okoye teased and ridiculed him about Nakia, BP reprimanded them by saying, "Are you finished?". In Politeness theory, reprimand belongs to negative face threatening act affecting the H's face. He used politeness strategy 'bald on record' as their social distance is as kin. BP said to Shuri, "Update? No. It worked perfectly. (3.5)" after Nakia told him that she have developed an update. BP seemed refused and disagreed by saying, "Update? No. It worked perfectly." In Politeness theory, disagreement belongs to positive face threatening act affecting the H's face. Disagreement indicates the S thinks H is wrong or misguided or unreasonable about some issue, such a wrongness being associated with disapproval. BP said baldly as it is efficient to talk that way with his own sister instead. Bald on record is used as a way to interact with the H without any effort to reduce the

threat to the H's face. Shuri asked to BP, "How many times do I have to teach you? Just because something works doesn't mean that it cannot be improved. (3.6)" Hearing BP's responds, Nakia reprimanded his brother quickly. In Politeness theory, reprimand indicates the S does not like/ want one or more of H's wants acts, personal characteristics, goods, beliefs, or values. Reprimand belongs to positive face threatening act affecting the H's face. The question "how many times do I have to teach you?" is an example of using politeness strategy 'bald on record'. It is because bald on record used when the S does nothing to reduce the threat to the H's face. BP said to Nakia, "You are teaching me? What do you **know?** (3.7)" BP reprimanded his sister back by saying, "You are teaching me? What do you know?" In Politeness theory, expression of reprimand belongs to positive face threatening act affecting the H's face. It shows that S has negative evaluation of some aspect of H's positive face. The politeness strategy BP used is bald on record. it is because he does no desire to maintain shuri's face. He used politeness strategy of 'bald on record' since he did nothing to reduce the threat to the H's face. Also, BP did not have desire to maintain Shuri's face because their social distance is close as family. Shuri answered BP, "More than you. (3.8)" Nakia answered BP's reprimand by saying. "More than you." In Politeness theory, reprimand is positive face threatening act

affecting the H's face. It indicates that the S does not like/ want one or more of H's wants, acts, personal characteristics, goods, beliefs, or values. She said it baldly without any effort to reduce the threat to the hearer's face. **BP said to Shuri, "I can't wait to see what kind of update you make... to your ceremonial outfit. (3.9)"**Black Panther ridiculed his sister about her ceremonial outfit will be. In Politeness theory, ridicule belongs to positive face threatening act affecting the H's face. It indicates that the S does not like/ want one or more of H's wants acts, personal characteristics, goods, beliefs, or values. Since their relationship as brother sister it is normal in close social distance to talk baldly as politeness strategy. The politeness strategy of bald on record does nothing to reduce the threat to the H's face.

4. CF4 00:33:34- 00:34:33

- 1. BP Come home, Nakia.
- **2.** N I'm right here
- 3. BP Stay.
- **4. N** I came to support you and to honor your father... but I can't stay. I found my calling out there. I've seen too many in need just to turn a blind eye. I can't be happy here... knowing that there's people out there who have nothing.
- 5. BP What would you have Wakanda do about it?
- 6. N Share what we have. We could provide aid... and access to technology and refuge to those who need it. Other countries do it, we could do it better.
- 7. BP We are not like these other countries, Nakia. If the world found out what we truly are... what we possess... we could lose our way of life.
- 8. N Wakanda is strong enough to help others and protect ourselves at the same time.
- 9. BP If you were not so stubborn, you would make a great

queen.

10. N I would make a great queen because I am so stubborn.

Context:

After Black Panther having crowned, he walks around with Nakia. He asked Nakia to stay in Wakanda. But Nakia refused him because she already found his passion out there to help people who have nothing. Black Panther once again asked Nakia what Wakanda can do for it.

Analysis:

BP said to Nakia, "Come home, Nakia. (4.1)" and "Stay. (4.3)"
Black Panther asked Nakia to come home and stay in Wakanda.
Those sentences BP served to Nakia are order sentences. In
Politeness theory, order belongs to negative FTA affecting the H's
face. The request is marked by those imperative sentences. Black
Panther's request restricted Nakia's personal freedom. The
politeness strategy he used is bald on record. It does little or no
desire to maintain the H's face. Besides, it is normal way to interact
since their social distance as a kin. BP said to Nakia, "What
would you have Wakanda do about it? (4.5)" Black Panther
asked Nakia since she has a reason why she will not stay in
Wakanda as he requested. This sentence included in offering. Offer
belongs to negative FTA affecting the H's face. In Politeness
theory, offer means the S put some pressure on H to accept or

reject, and possibly to incur a debt. The question "What would you have to Wakanda do about it?" is an example how the politeness strategy of 'positive politeness' is used. The politeness strategy of positive politeness is used as a way to make the hearer feel a sense of closeness and belonging. Also, exaggerate interest in H and his interests. Nakia said to BP, "Share what we have. We could provide aid... and access to technology and refuge to those who need it. Other countries do it, we could do it better. (4.6)" Nakia told him bravely what Wakanda should do to help the people who have nothing. She served strong negative emotions; lust. It indicates that S shows possible motivation for harming H. She used the politeness strategy 'bald on record' since efficiency is necessary to do. BP answered Nakia, "We are not like these other countries, Nakia. If the world found out what we truly are... what we possess... we could lose our way of life. (4.7)" BP tried to refuse Nakia by reminding what Wakanda was. Reminder belongs to negative FTA affecting the H's face. It indicates the S damages his own face to make the H remember to do certain act. BP used the politeness strategy of 'positive politeness' because it is used as a way to make the H feel a sense of closeness and belonging. BP said' "If the world found out what we truly are.. what we possess.. we could lose our way of life." means there is included both the S and the H in activity. Nakia said to BP,

"Wakanda is strong enough to help others and protect ourselves at the same time. (4.8)" After hearing BP, Nakia reprimanded BP that Wakanda is strong enough to help people out Wakanda. Reprimand means the S does not like/ want one or more of H's wants or acts. This act belongs to positive face threatening act affecting the H's face. She said it baldly as she has no desire to maintain the H's face. BP said to Nakia, "If you were not so stubborn, you would make a great queen. (4.9)" Black Panther does not like Nakia's want BP states ridicule to Nakia as she wants Wakanda to do more in helping people was disagreed by him. Ridicule means the S does not want/ like one or more of the H's wants, acts, personal characteristics, etc. Ridicule belongs to negative face threatening act affecting the H's face. BP used the politeness strategy of 'bald on record' since their social distance as ex-lovers it is normal they did nothing to reduce the threat to the H's face. Nakia replied, "I would make a great queen because I am so stubborn. (4.10)" Hearing BP's ridicule, Nakia said "I would make a great queen because I am so stubborn" as her ridicule to BP. Nakia used the politeness strategy of 'bald on record' since their social distance as ex-lovers it is normal they did nothing to reduce the threat to the H's face.

1. S I have great things to show you, Brother. Here are your communication devices for Korea. Unlimited range, also

Context:

Black Panther came to Shuri's lab to see a developed update she made. During she explained it, she got shocked seeing her brother wore old sandals into her lab. They ridiculed each other.

Analysis:

Shuri said to BP, "The real question is what are those? Why do you have your toes out in my lab? (5.3)" Nakia got shocked when found her brother wore old sandals into her lab, she stated reprimand to his brother, it is marked by her question, "Why do you have your toes out in my lab?" reprimand means Shuri does not like BP's act to wear old sandals into her lab. Reprimand belongs to positive face affecting the H's face. It indicates the S does not like/want one or more of H's wants, acts, personal characteristic, etc. she used the politeness strategy of 'bald on record' since she spoke with his brother who has close social distance with her. It is no or little desire to maintain the H's face when he/she is in close relationship with the S. Shuri said, "I bet

the Elders loved that. (CHUCKLES) Try them on. Fully automated. Like the old American movie Baba used to watch. (5.5)" Shuri stated ridicule to his brother about his sandals that it would make the elders loved that, it is marked by her saying, "I bet the Elders loved that." In politeness theory, ridicule belongs to positive face threatening act affecting the H's face. Ridicule means the S does not like/want one or more of H's wants, acts, personal characteristic, etc. shuri said it baldly since she has a talking with her own brother. The S no needed desire to maintain the H's face when he/she is in close relationship with the S.

Analysis:

Shuri said to BP, "- Old? Functional, but old. "Hey, people are shooting at me. "Wait, let me put on my helmet. (6.1)" Shuri teased his brother for her developing update of BP's outfit by ridiculing her brother. Ridicule is marked by Shuri's saying, "Functional, but old. "Hey, people are shooting at me. "Wait, let me put on my helmet." In politeness theory, ridicule belongs to positive face threatening act affecting the H's face. Ridicule shows that the S does not like/want one or more of H's wants, acts, personal characteristic, etc. she used politeness strategy of 'bald on record' because their social distance as family, she did no desire to maintain BP's face. Shuri said to BP, "Now tell it to go on. The entire suit sits within the teeth of the necklace. Strike it! (6.5)" Shuri ordered his brother to strike her developed suit she prepared for his brother. The order is marked by sentence, "strike it!" in politeness theory, order belongs to negative face threatening act affecting the H's face. Orders means the S tried to make some pressure to the H to do some act for the S. Shuri said it using politeness strategy of 'bald on record' since her interlocutor is her

own brother, she did nothing to reduce threat to the BP's face. Shuri said to BP, "- Mmm-hmm. Not that hard, genius! (6.7)" After doing as Shuri ordered to him, Shuri got shocked that BP strike very hard. She reprimanded and ridiculed his brother all at once. Her reprimand to BP is marked by sentence, "Not that hard" and her ridicule to him is marked by calling him, "genius!" In politeness theory, either reprimand or ridicule is belonging to negative face threatening act affecting the H's face. Those acts are indicating that the S does not like/want one or more of H's wants, acts, personal characteristic, etc. She used politeness strategy of 'bald on record' because their social distance as family, she did no desire to maintain BP's face. Shuri said to BP, "I invite you to my lab, and you just kick things around? Well, maybe you should make it a little stronger. Hey. Wait a minute. Absorb the kinetic energy... and hold it in place for redistribution. (6.9)" Shuri reprimanded her brother by saying, "I invite you to my lab, and you just kick things around?" in politeness theory, reprimand is included to positive face threatening act affecting the H's face. Shuri had no desire to maintain BP's face and do reprimand as indicates that she does not like/want one or more of H's wants, acts, personal characteristic, etc. she used politeness strategy of 'bald on record' since they are having close social distance as a family, she did nothing to reduce threat to the hearer's face. Shuri asked to BP, "Strike it again in the same spot. (6.11)" Shuri ordered his brother to strike the suit again in the same spot. The order is marked by imperative sentence, "Strike it again in the same In Politeness theory, order belongs to negative face spot." threatening act affecting the H's face. Orders means the S tried to make some pressure to the H to do some act for the S. Shuri said it using politeness strategy of 'bald on record' since her interlocutor is her own brother, she did nothing to reduce threat to the BP's face. BP asked to Nakia, "Delete that footage. (6.14)" BP ordered his sister to delete the recording. The order is marked by imperative sentence, "Delete that footage." in politeness theory, order belongs to negative face threatening act affecting the H's face. Orders means the S tried to make some pressure to the H to do some act for the S. He said it using politeness strategy of 'bald on record' since his interlocutor is his own sister, he did not need to reduce threat to the BP's face.

Context:

BP, Nakia and Okoye came to South Korean in a place where they can meet Klaue. They want to arrest Klaue because he robbed many vibranium of Wakanda's own. Okoye who has a bald headed tried to look normal by wearing wig on her head. But she seemed uncomfortable with that. Nakia tried to make her being calm and comfortable with that by saying how she supposed to be with her wig. Then, when they got into the place, BP and Nakia as ex-lovers they talked something intimated moreover all of their voices were connecting each other so Okoye can hear that too. Okoye reprimanded them to more focus on what will they do there and asked them to spread out.

Analysis:

Okoye said, "Bast willing, this will go quickly... and I can get this ridiculous thing off my head. (7.2)" and "What? It's a disgrace. Spread out. (7.4)" Okoye which has a bald headed should use a wig to look normal just like another in the place where they can meet Klaue. She looked very uncomfortable with that. She shows his hatred by saying, "Bast willing, this will go quickly...

and I can get this ridiculous thing off my head." And "What? It's a disgrace" also, Okoye ordered Nakia and BP to spread out. It is marked by imperative sentence, "Spread out" In politeness theory, hatred is included in strong negative emotions. It is belonging to negative face threatening act affecting the H's face. Showing strong negative emotions indicates that the S has a possible motivation for harming H or H's goods. While order means the S wants the H to do some acts for the S by giving pressure. Nakia answered to BP, "Ah... I got into a disagreement with some ivory traders. -Made a bit of a mess. (7.6)" BP asked Nakia what the woman outside the place means when saying something to Nakia, then Nakia confessed to BP that there is accident in the past with the woman outside. Confession Nakia said is, "Ah... I got into a disagreement with some ivory traders. - Made a bit of a mess." In politeness theory, confession is included in positive face threatening act affecting the Speaker's face. Nakia confessed something about herself which can damage her own face to the H, Black Panther. Okoye said to BP and Nakia, "Can we please focus? Thank you. (7.9)" Because of technology, they can connect and hear voice each other although in long distance. Hearing Nakia and Black Panther started talking outside this job; find Klaue, Okoye reprimanded them by asking question and giving thanks, "Can we please focus? Thank you." In politeness theory, reprimand

belongs to positive face threatening act affecting the H's face. It indicates that the S does not like/want one or more of H's wants, acts, personal characteristic, etc. she used politeness strategy of 'bald on record' since they are having close social distance as a kin, so she did not need to reduce threat to the hearer's face. **Okoye said to Nakia, "How could you miss Greased Lightning there behind you?** (7.11)" Okoye reprimanded BP for being carelessly count Klaue's people around. In politeness theory, reprimand belongs to positive face threatening act affecting the H's face. It indicates that the S does not like/want one or more of H's wants, acts, personal characteristic, etc. she used politeness strategy of 'bald on record' since they are having close social distance as a kin, so she did not need to reduce threat to the hearer's face.

- **2. R** Your Highness.
- **3. BP** You are buying from Klaue.

Context:

In that place, BP met Ross, his old friend who works for CIA. They warned and threaten each other deciding who will arrest Klaue for

stealing vibranium of Wakanda in a museum. BP tried to warn Ross and just the opposite. Ross told BP that they were even to help each other, and now they should concern on their own business about Klaue.

Analysis:
