

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

After analyzing the data in chapter IV, the next chapter is conclusion and suggestion. This is the last part of the research about assertive and directive acts found in the English translation of Surah Luqman by Dr. Mustafa Khattab. The conclusion is taken based on the findings and analysis that is done by the researcher. It is used to answer the research questions.

A. Conclusion

Based on the research findings and the analysis about utterances that is found in the English translation of Surah Luqman by Dr. Mustafa Khattab in the chapter IV, there are some conclusions that can be drawn on this study.

Based on the first problem “what are the types of assertive acts found in the English translation of Surah Luqman by Dr. Mustafa Khattab?”, the researcher concludes that there are eight types of assertive acts in the English translation of Surah Luqman by Dr. Mustafa Khattab, they are assure (8), inform (5), state (4), claim (4), remind (2), disclaim (1), criticize (1), and affirm (1). The most frequent type that appears is assure with total 8 data.

As for the second problem “what are the types of directive acts found in the English translation of Surah Luqman by Dr. Mustafa Khattab?”, the researcher concludes that there also eight types of directive acts in the English translation of Surah

Luqman by Dr. Mustafa Khattab, they are order (4), forbid (3), ask (3), advise (2), warn (2), tell (2), urge (1), and command (1). The most frequent type that appears is order with total 4 data.

There are many moral values in this surah in which could lead people to be a good human in this era. In addition, through Luqman's words, parents could learn how to teach their children properly so that their children would be good children as they expected.

B. Suggestion
