## **CHAPTER VI**

## CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents the conclusion and suggestion concerning with the result of the study. Based on the findings and discussion as presented in the previous chapter the researcher gets a conclusion as follow.

## A. Conclusion

Based on the research findings and the discussion about the practice of teaching English writing, it can be concluded that:

In practicing the teaching of writing, the teacher used three main activities those are: giving motivation, applying the strategy, and the last giving evaluation. The way the teacher motivated the students is by conducted stretching (brain exercise), singing together, and connecting the objective of the study with real-life. And in applying the strategy, the teacher used NHT strategy that applied by using throwing game.

Those activities have a good response from the students proven by the result of the questionnaire. The result of the questionnaire shows that the whole activities like stretching, singing, connecting the objective of the study to the real-life, and using NHT strategy that conducted by the teacher has motivated them to learn English writing. so, it can be concluded that the teaching writing at MAN 2 Malang is fun, joyful and can enhance the student's enthusiasm in learning.

## **B.** Suggestion

Based on the result of the research findings the researcher would like to give some suggestion for the following people:

For English teachers, in the process of teaching and learning it is critical that students be engaged and inspired so that when they enter the real world they can achieve and succeed. To motivate students to achieve, as educators we must recognize what engages them and what is required for them to be successful.

For the future researcher who wants to conduct research with the same theme as this research. The future researcher also can try to find a different product. In addition, this research used descriptive qualitative design with observation, interview, and questionnaire as the instrument of the research, so for the next researcher suggested to use larger subjects than this study with another design of research.
