

CHAPTER VI

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

Based on the description of the findings presented in the previous chapter, conclusions and suggestions are present in this chapter.

A. Conclusion

Based on the research findings and discussion above, the researcher can conclude that the teacher who is good at teaching English in a regular class at Junior High School 01 Ngunut Tulungagung which are characterized with the use of English in both in and out of classroom activities by the students use various strategies.
