### **CHAPTER V**

## **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS**

In this chapter, the researcher presents the conclusion after getting the result of the research, and the suggestion to the further research.

#### A. Conclusion

Based on the research result that was described in chapter IV, the researcher draws the following conclusion:

- 1. Students' descriptive writing before being taught by using Edmodo is low. It can be seen from mean score of pre test is 16.30. Minimum score of pre test was 12 and maximum score was 21.
- 2. Students' descriptive writing after being taught by using Edmodo is high and better than before. The post test score was higher than pre test score. It can be seen from post test score was 21.33. Minimum score of post test was 15 and maximum score was 25.
- 3. From pre test and post test score, there is significant different score of students' descriptive writing before and after being taught by using Edmodo. it means that teaching descriptive writing by using Edmodo is effective.

### **B.** Suggestions

The following suggestions are presented for those who are willing to contribute to the present study by conducting studies on using edmodo in writing skill. They are as follows:

#### 1. The Students
