

## CHAPTER VI

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

After analyzing and interpreting the founding data, the last chapter to be presented is conclusions and suggestions. In this chapter, the conclusion of this study will be presented with suggestion. This is the last chapter which served the research of illocutionary act of Sherlock Holmes in movie Sherlock Holmes: The Empty Hearse. The conclusion is as the answer based on the formulated research question.

#### A. Conclusion

Based on research finding and analysis of the utterance used by the main character of Sherlock Holmes, it contains illocutionary act which in its theory has 5 types. So, to make it easy, it can be concluded that:

1. The type of illocutionary act uttered by the main character that appears in the movie script there are 5 types, those are representatives act, directive act, commissive act, expressive act and declarative act. Those types are agreed with the theory of Searle. The illocutionary act mostly used is representatives act which appears 120 times.
2. In terms of illocutionary act, it is still divided more deeply to classify the type into some paradigm, it is called as force. There are so many forces to each type of illocutionary act.
  - a) Representatives act they are : (1) act of assert, (2) act of state, (3) act of report, (4) act of conclude, (5) act of believing.

- b) Directives act they are : (1) asking act, (2) command act, (3) request act, (4) warn act, (5) suggest act, (6) beg act, (7) pray act, and (8) invite act.
- c) Commissive act they are : (1) act of refusing, (2) act of promising, (3) act of offering, and (4) act of guarantee
- d) Expressive act they are : (1) apologize act, (2) act of deplore, (3) thanking act, (4) appreciate act, (5) congratulate act, (6) condolence act, (7) welcome act.
- e) Directive act is only nominate act

Thus, based on the research finding, it can be concluded that those two conclusion statement above is answer the research problem in Sherlock Holmes movie: The Empty Hearse. Those type and force is related with the theory thought by Searle and support by Yule.

## **B. Suggestion**

After the writer getting the result of analysis about the illocutionary acts which is used by main character in Sherlock Holmes movie: The Empty Hearse, the writer want to give suggestions as considerations which are important for reader and the other writer as follows:

### **1. English Learners**
