

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter presents the conclusion and suggestion. The conclusion draws based on formulated research question, while suggestion intended to give information to the other researchers who would be interested in doing similar research.

A. Conclusions

The writer arrived at the conclusion after analyzing and interpreting an obtained data in previous chapter. Based on the findings and analysis, it can be concluded that there are five types of illocutionary acts used by Tris as the main character in *Allegiant* movie. They are representative, directive, commissive, expressive and declarative acts. In term of illocutionary acts, representative is most dominantly used by the main character. Representative shows the true condition of the meaning in the utterance. Representative explains that believe to be the case, but on the other sides, it does not obligate to ourself, others also can believe that. The kind of representative which often used is stating. It shows that Tris gets a condition that she never got before and it was real for her So, this study reveals that Tris as a great woman which understand who she is, and to what purpose she belongs her life. From the utterance that used by Tris, it might contains of some messages. So, we as the audience must be able to take the possitive message from the utterance that has been conveyed by the character.

In addition, from this study it can be known that context is needed to know the intended meaning of the utterance. Context has an important role in interpreting a sentence. The same utterance will have different meaning if the context of each utterance is different.

B. Suggestion

From the conclusion before, the writer analyzes speech acts, especially illocutionary acts, to give more attention to the form of speech acts; like direct and indirect, also literal and non literal. So, they do not only find the explicit meaning but also the implicit ones. For the student, especially English student, who are interested in analyzing movie using pragmatics, hopefully this research would help them to get better understanding. They can also rich their knowledge by reading other literature sources.

The writer hopes this research will be useful for the readers and other researcher to get better understanding about speech acts, especially illocutionary acts.
