#### **CHAPTER VI**

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter contains of two part: (1) The conclusion of the activities of debater students at Senior High School 1 Trenggalek in maintaining her speaking skill, (2) The suggestions derived from the implications of the conclusions.

### A. Conclusion

The conclusion of this study is that in maintaining speaking skill based on the debater student's experience at Senior High School 1 Trenggalek uses various activities. They are doing time management, reading journal and news, self-talk activity, practice debate, watching debate video on You Tube and movie/film without subtitle, having chit-chat in *Whatsapp* by using bilingual language with debate team or senior, replying foreign people tweet in *Twitter*, learning grammar on *Instagram*, coercion and motivation to achieve targets (force and push herself), and make an evaluation book.

Based on the finding above, the researcher conclude that to be a good speaker in English, we must work hard, practice regularly and continuously, do some activities that support and make us easier in learning target language. Not only from inside and outside, but available media also can be used to support learning process.

# **B.** Suggestion

Based on the drawn conclusion above, there are some suggestions which are important to be considered by other students, English teacher and also other researchers.

### 1. Other students

From the experience of debater student at Senior High School 1 Trenggalek, the other students who do not joining debate team can choose various activities to improve speaking skill. Then, practice it regularly and continuously to maintain speaking skill.

## 2. English teacher

The English teacher can suggest various activities that used by the debater student to be applied by the students in the class and daily life.

### 3. Other researchers

Because of corona, the condition of our country is limited. It is impossible to conduct direct interview. So, this study is still lack on some aspect. The researcher hope that the next researcher should study this theme more and more thoroughly and the results would be more detailed
