

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

This last chapter presents two sub chapters, the conclusions and the suggestions of this study.

A. Conclusions

The objective of this research are to identify the main characters' characterization in the "The Theory of Everything" Movie. They are about the main characters physical appearances, personalities, social status, and social relationships. There are two main characters in this movie, Stephen Hawking and Jane Wilde Hawking.
