

CHAPTER III

RESEARCH METHOD

A. Research Design

Research methodology is commonly defined as a way or method to thinking and prepared to completed the research and reach the goal of the research. In this study the writer uses descriptive qualitative research to described the educational value that included in *Finding Nemo* movie. According to Bogdan and Biklen (1998) qualitative research is descriptive. The data collected is in the form of word or pictures rather than numbers. Processed the data take from various sources, transcript movie, articles, etc. Consecutively, this study deals with descriptive way to collect data. It is intended to described the educational value in *Finding Nemo* movie.

Based on the explanation above, the researcher more prior in accurate explanation to analyzed and present what have been found in the movie. The researcher was the used library research to completed the research.

B. Data Sources

Data is information, usually the form of fact or statistic that you can analyzed (Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary). The source of data is the sources where the data was obtained. The source of data can be divided into two kinds, primary and secondary data. The primary data for the analyzed is taken from movie. While the secondary data was derive from another sources, such as

books, website, journal and other materials that can support the primary data. Here the writer used the dialogue transcript of *Finding Nemo* movie to support the primary data.

C. Data Collection Method

Data collecting method is the writer's ways in collecting the data. Donald Ary says (2010) that implies that qualitative research may also use written documents to understand the phenomenon under the study. There are some ways to collect data, such as: interview, questionnaire, and documentation. The data in this research was collected using the documentary technique. Documentation is the method used in scientific research in order to collect data by using the document of evidence list. Documentation technique which researchers tried to find the data needed, such as notes, transcripts, newspapers, books, magazines and so on. In this research, the researcher analyzed the educational values of *Finding Nemo* movie by recording the relevant dialogues in a paper. In collecting data, the researcher did some steps that they were:

1. Watching the Finding Nemo movie

Finding Nemo is an interesting cartoon movie, this film was produced in 2003. The writer chose the film because of its interesting story besides that, the film provides educational value. Between dialogue and the action provide balance in this movie also the duration of this movie is about 90 minutes.

2. Reading the movie script

The movie script is taken from Finding Nemo website. It consist of plays on words, correct spelling of dialogues proper names, and the scenes. For the comparison the writer also uses the Indonesiansubtitle.

3. Analyzed the educational value

After the writer reading the movie script, then analyzed the dialogues and part of the movie which can analyzed as the educational value. Analyzed the dialogues and classify them according to its categories based on educational value.

D. Trustworthiness of the Study

The data of every study must be valid to check the validity of the data, of the present study was using credibility. According to Lisa (2008, p.895)in the qualitative research, Lisa said that trustworthiness has become an important concept because it allows researcher to describe the virtues of qualitative terms outside of the parameters that are typically applied in quantitative research. Credibility or truth value involves how well the researcher has established confidence in the findings Credibility value involves how well the writer has established confidence in the findings based on the research design, participants, and context.

In this study the credibility of the data was achieved by doing two important things, they were watching movie and reading the scripts. The

researcher saw the movie more than twice to analyze and make the data valid. The researcher also read the script frequently to get valid data.

E. Data Analysis

In data analysis the writer using method to analyzed the data. According to Bogdan (1998) described data analyzed is the process of systematically searching and arranging the interview transcript, field notes, and other materials that the researcher accumulated to increases her own understanding of them and to enable her to present what she has discover to other. In this process the writer uses some methods to get valid and true data.

1. Watching Finding Nemo movie

The writer focus and gave more attention in this step to every dialogue in order to get understanding about the educational in Finding Nemo movie. Interpreting the data found in dialogues.

2. Reading the script

The writer reading all dialogues in the script as to find the educational value in the movie.

3. Identifying the educational value found

The writer identify value in the movie by watching. Analyzed the dialogues and classify them according to its categories based on educational value.

4. Interpreting data

Then, the writer verify the dialogues with related theory in this research. After that gives the conclusion about the educational values in the movie.
