Title: IMPLEMENTATION OF ISLAMIC RELIGIOUS LEARNING STRATEGIES IN AUTISTIC CHILDREN IN INDONESIA

Esteemed Editor-in-Chief, esteemed author(s),

I think that the text of the article has been significantly improved. Below are some additional suggestions:

- The abstract in Serbian should be proof-read.

- It is recommended that the numbers up to nine (including nine) in the whole text be written in letters, not numerals (for example: Meanwhile, the total number of principals and teachers in special schools is 963 people. Religious teachers in special schools are 97 or about ten percent of the total teachers; This condition illustrates that especially in religious lessons with a limited number of teachers and a small number of teaching hours, namely 4 hours a week, is a serious problem for schools to provide maximum religious subject matter...)

- It is not clear why the abbreviation for special school - SLB? Perhaps the authors could abolish this abbreviation. If they decide to leave SLB in the text, then they should delete the full name (special school) every next time (it is not recommended to use both the abbreviation and the full name at the same time).

- It is recommended that the authors add references to the following sentence: Religious education is the main basis for developing children's abilities and strengthening.

- Were teachers asked if they wanted to participate in the research? Could they have turned down this possibility? Were participants asked if they agreed to have the interviews recorded? Did they sign an agreement in that regard? If not, this should be added to the limitations.

- Were the results of the interview coded by two or more people? Has the inter-rater agreement between the researchers been checked? If not, this should be added to the limitations.

- The authors responded to almost all the requests from the previous review. However, I am copying a comment that they almost did not take into account at all. Authors are encouraged to consider some of the ideas from this comment: "The third topic is about the strategies the respondents from your research use. There is an impression that the professionals from this specimen use basic strategies based on drawing, colouring and reading. It is necessary that the authors critically comment on the presented results and suggest the way these teachers' work can be improved in the future." For example, the authors might point out that their teachers, although having good results, did not use strategies (evidence-based teaching practice) such as reinforcement, discrete trial teaching, extinction, modeling, scripting, visual support, or some others. Perhaps the effect of their work would have been greater or different had they used these strategies. This critical review should be added to the section: SUPPORTING AND CONSTRAINTS FACTORS OF ISLAMIC RELIGIOUS LEARNING IN CHILDREN WITH AUTISM. It should be supported by references. The ways in which these teachers work should be compared with the strategies used by other teachers in other, but similar research.
