

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

After analyzing and interpreting the acquiring of the data in the previous study, this chapter presents the conclusion of the study and the suggestion.

A. Conclusion

Based on the data finding and analysis in the last chapter, finally the researcher conclude that there are eight kind of expressive act that used by the main characters in the movie “The Chronicles of Narnia: The Voyage of The Dawn Treader” by: C. S Lewis. Those are three expression of *like* that were found by researcher in this study such as *It’s great to see you, Well, whatever the case, I’m just glad to be here, what a pleasure.* Those are one expression of *Dislike* that was found by researcher in this study such as *Yeah, instead I’m stuck here.* There are five expressions of *refusing* that were found by the researcher in this study, such as *Not in this world, No, it’s yours, No!, I am not your subject, No.* There are two expression of *welcoming* that were found by researcher, such as *Hi, Uncle Harold, Hallo Reep.* There are two expression of *thanking* that were found by the researcher, such as *Thanks, Thanks, Reep.* There are five expression of *praising* that were found by the researcher, such as *That’s pretty!, I’m beautiful, You look beautiful, sister, Eustace, that’s brilliant!, You were a pretty good dragon.* There are two expressions of *blaming* that were found by the researcher, such as *I shouldn’t have left him, Oh no.* The last expressions that were

found by researcher in the movie “The Chronicles of Narnia: The Voyage of The Dawn Treader is *Apologizing*.
