CHAPTER VI

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter deals with the conclusion is drawn on the basic of the findings and discussion as presented in the previous chapter of the research

A. Conclusion

From the result of the study, it can be concluded that students' good proficiency is achieved by employing various learning strategies to mastery many aspect such as vocabulary, grammar, and pronunciation. The various learning strategie used by subjects are divide into five classifications as follows:

- 1. Enriching vocabulary such as: (a) memorizing, (b) making notes,
 - (c.) providing some of new vocabularies per day, (d) looking up dictionary.
- 2. Vocabulary practice such as applying new vocabulary in speaking daily activity.
- 3. Grammatical mastery such as having grammar books and write one by one of tenses in a paper then glue it at room wall.
- Pronounciation mastery such as sharing with other friends or teacher about grammar.
- 5. Speaking preparation and practice such as: (a) accustoming to train pronunciation includes imitating the pronunciation of words,

- (b) understanding of the theme that will be spoken, (c) writing what will be spoken, (d) controlling of emotion include deadening nervous and enjoy,
- (e) keeping on to practice wherever they are.

From the finding it can be concluded that good students' tend to employ various learning strategies.

Practically, the strategies employed by the students' are contributive to improve their speaking proficiency. First strategies is enriching vocabulary it is contributive to the students' proficiency in speaking in which the students are more easier to prepare before oral presentation. Second strategies is practicing vocabulary, it is contibutive to the students' proficiency, in which the students get a lot of vocabularies that they never heared before and it makes students to not easly forget the vocabularies that they had learned. Third strategies is grammatical mastery it is contributive to the students' proficiency in speaking for it keep them in constructing good sentences. Fourth strategies, pronounciation mastery, it is contributive to the students' proficiency in speaking in which the students can pronounce English words correctly. The last strategies are speaking preparation and practice, they are contributive to the students' proficiency in speaking such, in which the students are confidence to speak English.

Hence, by employing strategies, it gives positive contributions to support the students speaking ability. Through doing various learning strategies they can enrich their vocabulary, grammar and pronunciation. Those components are important possessed when the students are insisted to be proficient in speaking.

B. Suggestion
