CHAPTER V

DISCUSSION

After presenting and analyzing the data of expression in Harry Potter and Chamber of Secret movie script, the next part is discussion of whole data gathered to answer the research problem about the expressive speech act and the syntactical realization of the speech act in the Harry Potter and Chamber of Secret movie script. Based on the data that were got by researcher in chapter 4 the researcher find dislike expression appears more than another expression. From the 121 data that were found by researcher about expressive speech act, the 65 of them were dislike expression. It means the dislike expressions were the most often appear in the Harry Potter and Chamber of Secret movie script. More than half of data that were gathered by the researcher are dislike expression.

The dislike expressions appear so 65 times in this study. More than half of the data that were got by researcher were dislike expression. Dislike expression appear for many times because the story of Harry Potter is about orphan children who life unhappily with his aunt and his friend that hate him. Harry Potter was born as orphan. He life with his aunt. She dislikes with Harry Potter's Mother and she dislike when she knows Harry Potter must life with her. She and her family always angry with Harry Potter. They think Harry Potter is a trouble maker. The most scene of this movie is in the Hogward. in the Hogward. Harry has friend that hate him. He is always angry with Harry. Another reason is Harry and his friend as adolescence

always want to try novelties, so they often make a problem with all people around them that make all people around them angry and dislike with them. It is the reason about why dislike expression appear most often in the Harry Potter and Chamber of Secret Movie script. So, there are many scene in Harry's house are full with dialogues that express anger and dislike feeling.

According to George Yule (1996:55) the expressive speech act can be statement of pleasure, pain, like, dislike, joy, or sorrow. So, this study find five classifications expressive speech act by George Yule. In this study the researcher find there are many expressions in the Harry Potter and Chamber of secret movie script are indirectly expressed. Such as in the excerpt below.

From excerpt above the researcher know the context of the sentence *I'll bet you love* and *famous Harry Potter* are dislike expression although the meaning of that expression is not express the dislike feeling but from the context that expression is used by speaker to express his dislike feeling. They do not use sentence "I dislike

you" to express his dislike feeling but they prefer express his dislike feeling indirectly as Draco said in the excerpt above.

The study about speech act conducted by Yuwartatik (2013) in the novel The Black Cat the researcher find eight dialogue that are consist of expressive speech act. The expressive speech act form the novel The Black Cat is indirectly express feeling the speaker. In this study the researcher find 121 expressive speech act from the Harry Potter and Chamber of Secret movie script. That expressions are divided in to five category that are like, dislike, sorrow, pleasure, and joy. The expression of that are found by researcher also express the feeling of speaker indirectly.

There are many expressions that expressed indirectly in the Harry Potter and Chamber of Secret movie script. From this finding, we can conclude that native speaker usually express his feeling indirectly.
