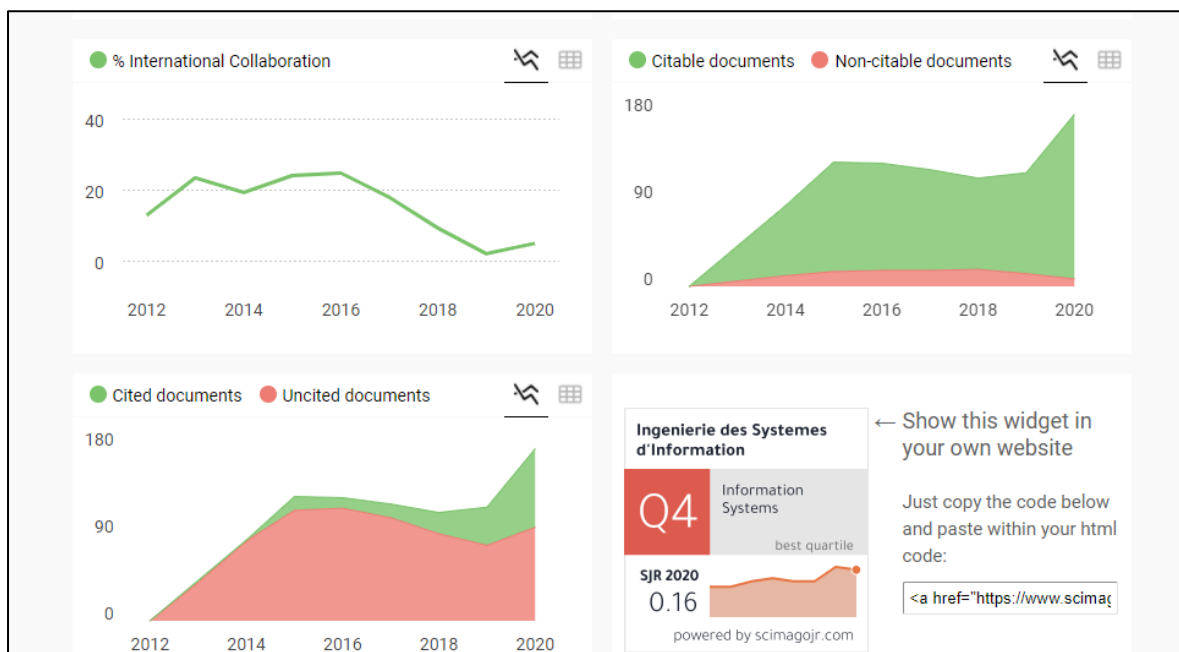
Ingénierie des Systèmes d'Information (ISI) is a top-rated international journal devoted to publishing the most innovative models, algorithms, software and hardware for information systems.

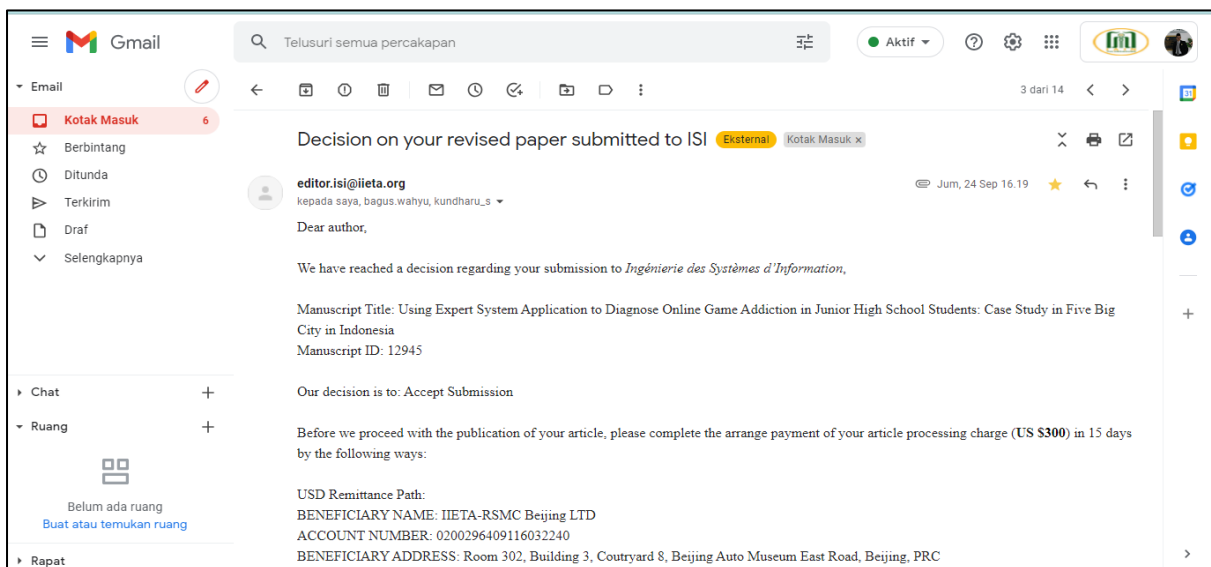
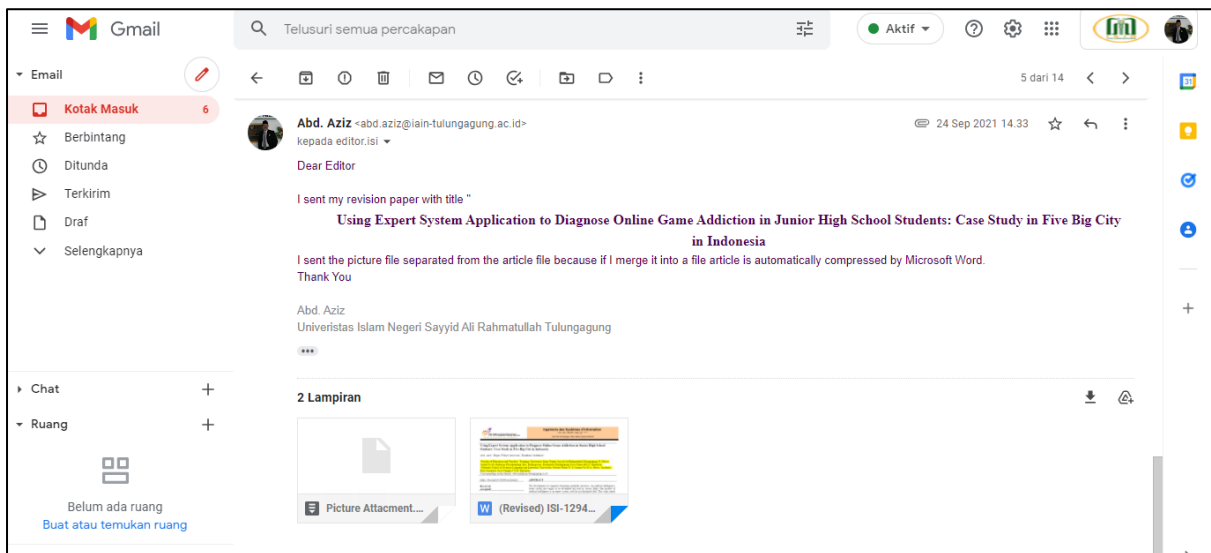
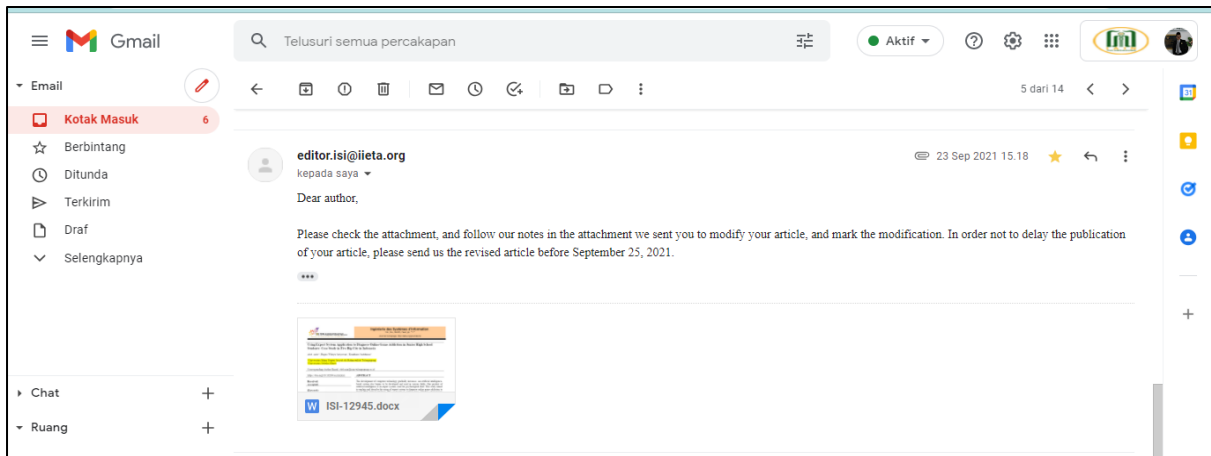
