

## CHAPTER II

### REVIEW OF RELATED LITERATURE

In chapter the researcher presents a review of related literature. The material of teaching, grammar, teaching grammar, simple past tenses, Hello English application, procedures of using Hello English application in teaching grammar, previous study.

#### A. Teaching

Teaching is the process of delivering learning materials to students with the aim of developing students' abilities. The goal of the teaching is a learning concept which helps teachers link the material teaches to students' real life situation and encourage students to make connections between the knowledge and its application in their lives. With the concept, learning results are faced with more meaningful for students. In the book entitled *Principles of Language Learning and Teaching*, Brown (2000:7) "Teaching is helping someone to learn how to guide in learning something so that it can provide knowledge to someone". In short, to teaching means mastery of certain knowledge, skills and skills that last for all person.

According to Harmer (2001:38) states that teenager is the best language learners. Harmer (2001:39) adds that "If teenager participantes in teaching learning activities, they have good creativity, a great learning capacity and a great passion for things that interest them". Interesting material for them can eliminate boredom and can make them enjoy and

concentrate on their learning process. Brown (2001:92) proposes some considerations to teach teenage students as the following:

1. Teenage students' intellectual processing, logical thinking, and linguistic metalanguage are developing,
2. Their attention spans are lengthening but can easily be shortened too,
3. Their capacity of abstraction is increasing,
4. Their ego, self-image, and self-esteem are the peak which make them very sensitive to how others perceive their physical changing, emotional selves and mental capabilities.

Teachers can motivate and pay attention to adolescent students by being warm and friendly (Newby, 2000:353). Nurhayati (2014) states the teachers must create the classroom enjoyable situation. The teacher must be given the positive condition in the classroom. Nurhayati (2018) defines a good teacher is a self-initiated teacher who not only comes for their own purpose but becomes a motivation for their students. An important factor of a student's motivation is the teacher. Nurhayati (2020) defines a motivation is anything that encourages someone to act to do something.

## **B. Grammar**

Grammar is sentence structure. By using the correct structure, a sentence will be perfect. This structure is used in all languages, not just English. Grammar are the rules that enable humans to form and interpret the words and sentences of their language. According to Coghill and Magendanz (2003: 16) stated that a structured set of rules in a language is grammar.

Words that are strung together and form a meaning affect grammar. Grammar must be structured with certain formula to make it sense. If those unstructured words are used in a communication, the information cannot be delivered well.

Coghill (2003: 16) noted that The grammar of a language is the set of rules that govern its structure. Grammar determines how words are arranged to form meaningful units. It means that grammar is a structure which should be patterned correctly to get a realistic meaning. If the students can't put the grammar correctly, it can raise a misunderstanding between their mind and the readers.

Grammar is the system of a language. Many people interpret grammar as the "rules" of language; but in reality no language has rules. If you use the word "rules," someone will make the rules first and then speak the language. But language doesn't start that way. Language begins with people making sounds that develop into words, phrases, and sentences. No commonly used languages were fixed. All languages change over time. What we call "grammar" is simply a reflection of the language at any given time. Nurhayati (2020) states that grammatical competence is needed in fulfilling talk competence since the understudies are able of create linguistically adjust sentences or articulations by being stumbling on this portion.

Grammar adds meanings that are not easily inferable from the immediate context. The kinds of meanings realised by grammar are principally :

1. Representational – that is, grammar enables us to use language to describe the world in terms of how, when and where things happen. Example: the sun set at 07.30. The children are playing in the garden.

2. Interpersonal – that is, grammar facilitates the way we interact with other people when, for example, we need to get things done using language.

Example: there is a difference between:

Ticket!

Ticket, please.

Can you show me your tickets?

May I see your tickets?

Would you mind if I had a look at your tickets.

For this reason, I have chosen a definition of grammar that is concise but that is sufficiently broad to include a wide range of language features and forms: grammar is the formal study of the structure of a language and describes how words fit together in meaningful constructions.

### **C. Teaching Grammar**

Teaching grammar can help students use phrases that are meaningful and correct. When students study grammar, they must be able to look at grammar from a linguistic perspective so they can know the true meaning of the text and reduce the number of misunderstandings. Without grammar, words relate without meaning. To be able to speak language to some level of competence we need to learn teaching grammar. According to Ellis (2006) Grammar teaching helps them in understanding the comprehension process

that involves instructional techniques that attract the attention of students. It means that the grammar teaching refer the process of transferring the set up of the grammar to the students which involves the instruction, method, or approaches in which the choose grammar teaching and how they apply them for the students. There are many arguments for placing grammar in the teaching of a second language. Here are three of them:

1. Sentence engine argument

Part of the language learning process is called item learning. memorizing individual items such as words and phrases. However, there is a limit to the number of items a person can store and retrieve. After all, grammar is a regular description of a language, and knowledge of these rules provides students with learning to produce original sentences. The number of possible new sentences is only limited by vocabulary according to the teacher's orders and creativity. Grammar is a kind of sentence-making machine. Therefore, grammar offers students to hone their limitless linguistic creativity.

2. Fine-tuning argument

The purpose of grammar is to acquire a greater meaning than the lexical system alone can fulfill. Although to get a communicative language just by stringing words and phrases together.

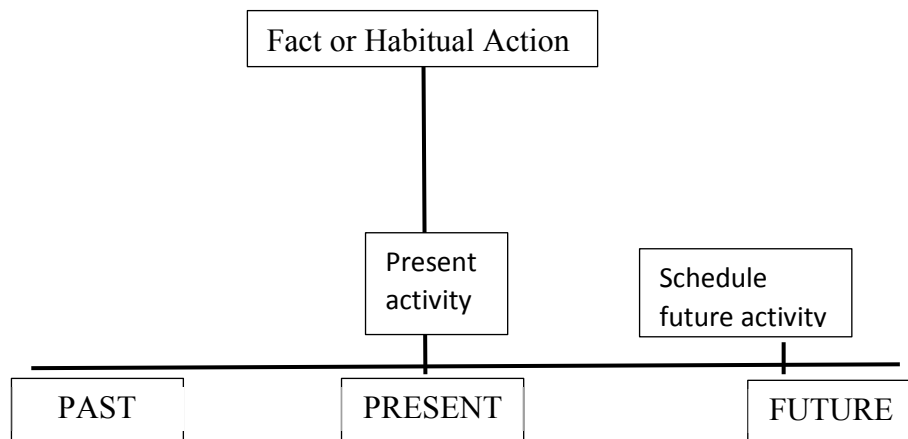
3. Rule of law argument

Because grammar is a system of rules that can be learned, so it is suitable for the view of teaching and learning are known as transmission.

The transmission view sees the role of education as the transfer of knowledge (usually in the form of facts and rules) from those who know those who do not. Such a view is usually associated with a type of institutionalized learning in which rules, order, and discipline are highly valued. The need for rules, discipline is highly applied in the classroom where students are unruly and unmotivated, a situation that English teachers face every day. In situations like these, grammar offers teachers a structured system that can be taught and tested in methodical steps.

#### **D. Simple Present Tense**

Tense is a systematic structure to show the timing of actions describing the various forms of the verb. Simple present tense is tense form used to state facts, habitual action (events that are repeated), general truth, or present (events that are happening at this time). According to Murphy (2003:4) “We use the simple present to express something that happens over and over again, or that something is generally true”. According to Swan (2005:448) stated that “We use the simple present when we talk about something that happens regularly all the time and doesn't just happen now”. The researcher can conclude that the simple present tense is a tense that is formed with a basic verb, except for the third singular subject such as he, she, and by adding –s or –es at the end and can be used to express things that we do everyday.

The simple present tense is used :

1. To express habits, general truths, repeated actions or unchanging situations, emotions and wishes :

**I smoke** (habit); **I work in London** (unchanging situation); **London is a large city** (general truth)

2. To give instructions or directions:

**You walk** for two hundred meters, then **you turn** left.

3. To express fixed arrangement, present or future:

Your exam **starts** at 09.00

4. To express future time, after some conjunctions:

**After, when, before, as soon as, until**

**He'll give to you when you come next saturday**

Kind of Simple Present Tense sentences :

1. Simple Present Tense Affirmative

**S + Verb (1) / to be ( is, am, are ) + O**

For example :

- She **reads** Harry Potter books every day.

- They **watch** new movies every Sunday.

## 2. Simple Present Tense Negative

To form a simple present tense negative sentence, usually the **don't** or **doesn't** before the verb, except **To Be** and **Modal**.

<b>S + Don't / Doesn't + Verb (1) + O</b>
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If the verb is to be, then the formula becomes

<b>S + ( is, am, are ) + not + O</b>
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For example :

- She doesn't read Harry Potter books every day.
- They don't watch new movies every Sunday.

## 3. Simple Present Tense Interrogative

To form interrogative/ question sentences, usually using extra **do** or **does** in front of the sentence.

<b>Do / Does + S + Verb (1) + O</b>
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The word **do** is used if its subjects are **I, you, they,** or **we**. However, word **does** is used if its subjects is a third person ( **she, he, it** ).

For example :

- Does she read a Harry Potter book ?
- Do they watch a new movie every day ?

If the verb is **To Be** or **Modal**, then do not use the word **do** or **does**.

- Are you new staff of Wall Street English ?



- Are they football fans of Arema Malang ?

### **E. Hello English Application**

In teaching and increasing students' understanding of grammar, the teacher must motivate students with a few learning media and make students learn more. The teacher must use the appropriate as well as one of the instructional media that can be used is the Hello English application can make students feel good when they learn English grammar. Additionally, the medium of the application can also make students readily understand the teaching of grammar because they can apply it directly in the oral or written form. As stated by Nusir (2013: 311) The use of gadgets as a medium in learning is not only entertainment but also has a positive impact on learning at school. The Hello English application can prevent students from easily getting bored with the monotonous teaching grammar. So students can learn grammar by being miserable.

The Hello English is an English language learning application, which allows users to learn the English language through interactive modules. It functions on a freemium pricing model. The application is available on Android, IOS, Windows and Web. The Hello English application is an interactive, personal, and contextual English. The learning application is designed specifically for English as a second language students. The Hello English application launched in October 2014. Hello English application is the most heavily downloaded educational application in Asia, and the third most accessible education application at Google Play Store ( beginning

January 2017 ). The purpose of Hello English is to get users to master English in their own native language, to understand grammar and vocabulary.

This application consistently maintains a high position based on free applications in the educational category. The Hello English covers 22 languages such as Indonesia, India, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Nepal, Qatar and many others. Hello English also includes all four aspects of language acquisition: reading, writing, listening and speaking with sophisticated recognition technology that enables learners to speak to applications and conduct real life. It pair interactive lessons with games and grammar comprehension. This medium offers a uniques and contextual toll that makes use of news. Sports and entertainment to help learners master their understanding of English grammar.

**Figure 2.3 Hello English application register**

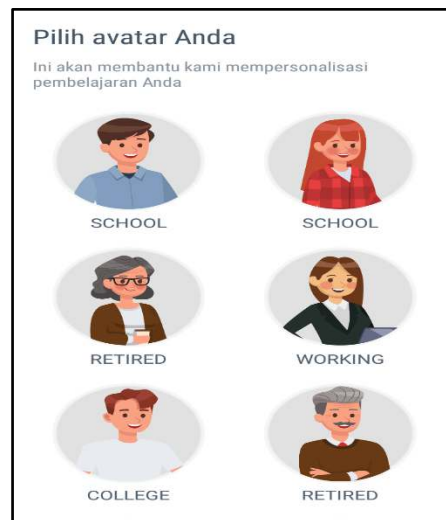

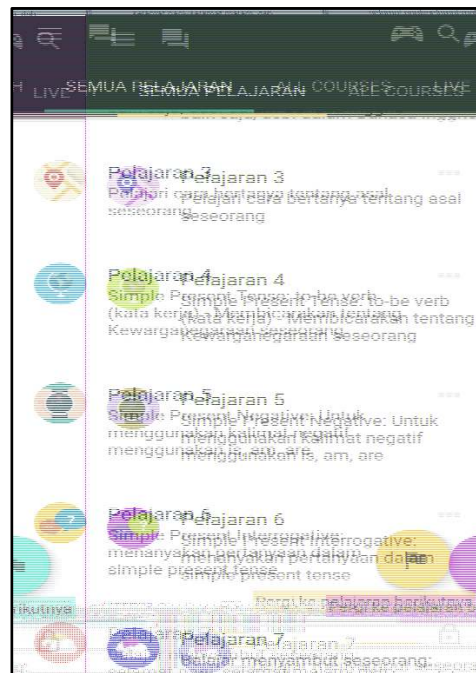

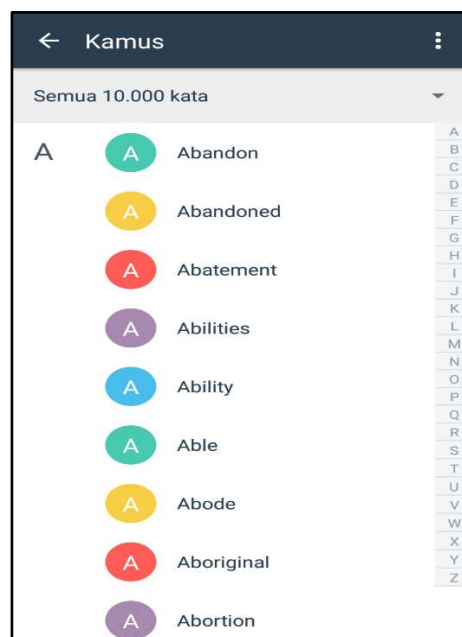

### **G. Testing Grammar**

Testing grammar is one of the mainstays of language testing, especially in English, because it can be said that basic knowledge of grammar underlies the ability to use language to express meaning. The most common way to test grammatical knowledge is a multiple-choice test, and the most common multiple-choice item is one in which students choose words to complete sentences correctly. Students can also be asked to choose the correct response to an utterance or choose the most equivalent statement. Error correction items are also useful in testing grammar. The traditional way to test knowledge of word order is to present alternative word orders and ask

students to choose the best one. An understanding of proper sentence order can be tested in the same way. The practice of combining sentences also plays a role in testing grammar. Meanwhile, testing grammar is limited because it does not guarantee that test-takers can use grammatical knowledge in daily communication. In preparing a grammar test, the teacher must consider the convenience to the students so that students more easily understand and are interested in learning grammar.

In this study, researcher used quasi-experimental Study at the Eighth Grade Students of SMPN 1 STM Hulu in Academic Year 2019/2020. The conclusion of this study was by using Hello English application is effective on the students’ vocabulary mastery development at SMPN 1 STM Hulu in Academic Year 2019/2020. The result of this study have revealed that the Hello English Application is an expected can give a lot of beneficial contribution to the students in add vocabullary.

Other previous research was conducted by Fendiasari from the State Islamic Institute of Tulungagung in 2020. The title of the research is "The Effectiveness of using Hello English Application to Teach Vocabulary at Tenth Grade Students of SMAN 1 Durenan". The researcher observes several theories and reads a number of books as references and information that relevant to the topics discussed. The author conducted research at SMAN 1 Durenan. In this study, researcher used quasi-experimental Study at Tenth Grade Students of SMAN 1 Durenan in Academic Year 2020. The conclusion of this study was by using Hello English application is effective on the students' vocabulary mastery development at Tenth Grade Students of SMAN 1 Durenan. The result of this study have revealed that the Hello English Application is an expected that studying can enlarge their knowledge in learning vocabulary.

In addition other previous research was conducted by Deswati from Muhammadiyah University of Surabaya in 2017. The title of the research is "The Effectiveness of Hello English Application 4th-6th and 9th-11th Lessons as The Alternative media for Teaching Grammar in seven graders in SMP Muhammadiyah 2 Surabaya". The researcher observes several theories and reads a number of books as references and information that relevant to the topics discussed. The author conducted research at SMP Muhammadiyah 2 Surabaya. In this study, research used pre-experimental method. There were 23 students in 7B class as subject of the study. This study focus on Simple present tense. The result of this study have revealed that the Hello English

Application is an excellent technique to motivate students and to improve their grammar achievement.

The difference between the previous studies mentioned above and this research is that the previous studies used different roles. In the research Rita focus on the vocabulary mastery for Junior High School. Seftya focus in the teaching vocabulary for Senior High School. Destawati focus on teaching grammar in simple present tenses for Junior High School used pre-experimental research. Whereas this study uses the application and focus on students' English grammar achievement. The grammar focus on simple present tense used quasi experimental research. This research wants to know the significant difference in students grammar between the students who are taught by using Hello English application and those who are not taught by using Hello English application at first grade of MTSN 6 Tulungagung in pandemic. This study aims to illustrate whether teaching grammar using the Hello English application for students in pandemic era covid 19 can increase the ability to learn grammar in the first grade students of MTSN 6 Tulungagung.
