Context of the utterance:

When finished training all troops entered the tent. Inside the tent the troops only wore underwear and rested while joking. Mulan was surprised to see her comrades half naked. At that time there was an order to take a bath together from the commander and someone was needed to volunteer the night watch on the watchtower. Mulan prefers to stay overnight in the watchtower.

Finally Mulan releases her chi so that the thrown glasses don't hit the people around her, especially her family.

volunteering to guard the watchtower overnight. The risk he took was that she had to stay up all night without sleeping and rest in order to avoid bathing with her troops.
