CHAPTER IV

DATA FINDING AND PRESENTATION

This chapter presents data findings and analysis of the study referring to the research questions being addressed. The findings related to the character education values found and the explication of the character education values reflected through the utterance of the figures in *Coco Movie*.

A. Character Education Values Found in *Coco* Movie

In this part, the researcher has obtained the result of the research. After conducting the document analysis by watching, reading, understanding, and analyzing the whole of *Coco* movie and the *Coco* movie script using the kind of character education values state by The Ministry of Education and Culture in the law No. 20, 2018 article 2, section 2. The 18 values sourced from religion, Pancasila, culture and educational purposes. Those are religious, honest, tolerant, discipline, work hard/ perseverance, creative, independent, democratic, curious, nationalism, patriotism, appreciative, friendly/communicative, love peace, like to read, environmental awareness, social awareness, and responsibility.

Based on the document analysis conducted by the researcher, 42 data reflected the character education values. Then from 42 data found in *Coco Movie* contained 15 character education values. Those are religious, honest, tolerant, discipline, work hard/perseverance, creative, independent, democratic, curious, patriotic, appreciative, friendly/communicative, love peaceful, social awareness,

and responsible. While there are 3 character education values that have not been reflected in *Coco Movie*, those are nationalism, like to read and environmental awareness. The data appeared and elucidated in sub-chapter below:

1. Appreciating Achievement

Appreciating Achievement means an attitude or act of confessing, considering, and respecting what other people achieved. These are the nine utterances contain the value of appreciating achievement:
