

CHAPTER IV

FINDINGS

This chapter presents the research findings of the study based on the formulated of research questions. The data were analyzed based on the data classification that was related to moral values that were found and characterizations shown by the main characters on *Maya the Bee* movie.

A. Moral values Found in *Maya the Bee* Movie.

In this part, the writer has obtained the result of the research. As stated by Indonesian law on Permendikbud No. 20 of 2018 as the parameter in this research, there are 18 moral values, religiosity, honesty, tolerance, discipline, hard work, creativity, independence, democrat, curiosity, national spirit, patriotism, appreciating achievement, friendliness, like to read, love peace, environmental care, social care and responsibility.

While in the *Maya the Bee* movie the researcher found 35 data reflected moral values. Then from 35 data found in *Maya the Bee* movie contained 13 moral values they are, honesty, tolerance, discipline, hard work, creativity, democrat, curiosity, patriotism, appreciating achievement, friendliness, love peace, social care, responsibility. Whereas there are 5 moral values that are not found in *Maya the Bee* movie there are, religiosity, independence, national spirit, like to read, environmental care. The moral values in the movie that found in the dialogue and presented here, appropriate the measure of moral values that have definite in previous.

For more detail, some of the moral values that exist in the Maya the Bee movie will be explained below as follows:

1. Honesty

According to Indonesian Law on Permendikbud No. 20 of 2018 honesty can be describe as attitude when dealing with something or certain phenomena and telling the facts without any lies or really in accordance with the reality that happened. There are three values of honesty that can be found in the Maya the Bee movie as following:

- a. The honesty value in this movie shown by Maya. In duration 00.52.56 she tells who has stolen the royal jelly to Ants army and her friend flip. That can be explicitly transcribed below.

Context: Maya and Flip were in the middle of the meadow. They wanted to look for Willy. Suddenly, they have met two ant's army. Maya said hello to the two ant's army was very surprised they found the baby bee. They asked Maya why she was in the meadow. Did she know the Queen was sick? Moreover, the royal jelly was stolen by hornets. Maya answered that the royal jelly thieves were not hornets but Buzzlina's adviser because she saw her with the royal jelly.

In Maya's dialogue, "***It was the adviser. I saw her with the royal jelly.***" This dialogue shows the value of honesty. Because Maya stated the truth about who stole the royal jelly was adviser Buzzlina when ant's army informed Maya that her Queen was sick and the hornets had stolen the royal jelly. From the dialogue above, the writer can be concluded that

Maya's behavior by telling the truth about who is the thief of royal jelly shows the value of honesty.

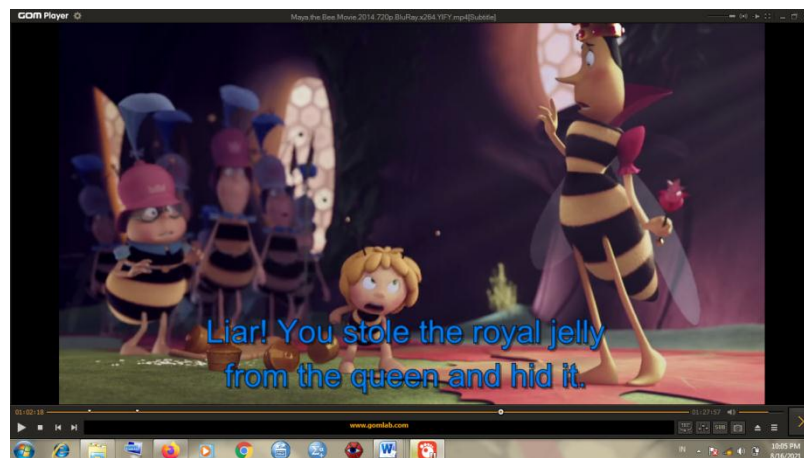
- b. The next honesty value shown by Maya. In duration 01.02.20 Maya tells to the Bees army that the adviser Buzzlina is the thief of royal jelly.

Context: Maya came back to the beehive, and she met with Buzzlina. Maya asked her where the Queen was. Buzzlina told her that she was the revenge of the Queen. Maya told the Bee army that Buzzlina was a liar; she stole the royal jelly and hid it. Nevertheless, no one believes Maya.

From Maya's dialogue, "*Liar! You stole the royal jelly from the Queen and hid it.*" Represent honesty value. The moral value of honesty is shown when adviser Buzzlina tells Maya that the Queen has passed away, and she declares herself as the revenge of the Queen. Maya tells the truth that Buzzlina is a liar, and she tells people who stole and hid the royal jelly is adviser Buzzlina to the Bees army.

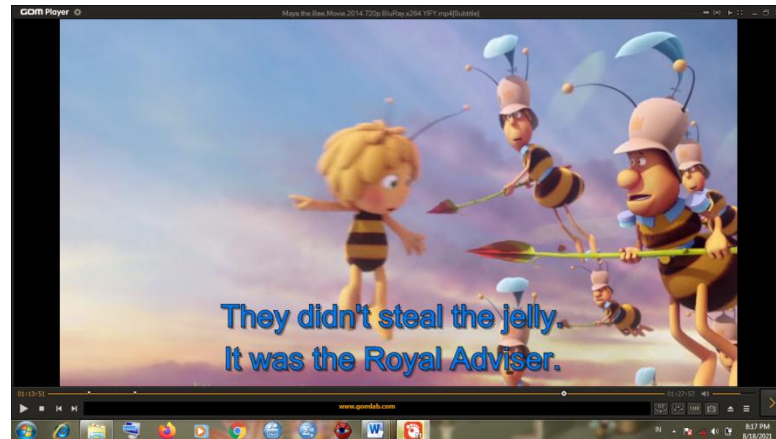
- c. The next value of honesty shown in duration 01.13.51 in this duration, Maya tells the truth who stole the Royal jelly is adviser Buzzlina not hornets.

Context: When the war between Hornet and Bees happens, Maya will stop the war. She told all of the Ants armies that Hornets was not the thief of royal jelly, it was the royal adviser, Buzzlina, and she hid the royal jelly under her crown.

 Maya : *Wait! They did not steal the jelly. It was the royal adviser. She is hiding it under her crown.*

In the sentence on Maya's dialogue, "*Wait! They did not steal the jelly. It was the royal adviser. She is hiding it under her crown.*" This dialogue shows the value of honesty because, in this part, Maya stopped the bee army when they wanted to attack hornets and tells the truth to them that hornets were not the royal jelly thief, but the royal jelly thief is Buzzlina. From that dialogue, the researcher can be concluded that honesty value can be seen in the Maya attitude when she tells the truth about who stole Queen royal jelly.

2. Tolerance

Tolerance can be described based on Indonesian Law on Permendikbud No. 20 of 2018 as behavior or attitude to respect the differences between religions, ethnicities, opinions, attitudes, and actions

of other people who are different from ourselves. The researcher found two values of tolerance in this movie they are:

- a. Value of tolerance shown by Queen of Bee. In duration 00.05,14 when Maya made a mistake that she did not mean to do. That can be explicitly transcribed below.

Context: Maya was a baby Bee. She was a very active bee. One day she was walking in the hive, suddenly she fell into the royal jelly-making machine. However, when she came out of the royal jelly-making machine, Maya bounced and almost dropped the royal jelly. Luckily, the royal jelly was saved by the guards. Knowing Maya's carelessness, Buzzlina scolded and punished her. The Queen came to them, and then she told Buzzlina to pull her stinger in because she was just a baby. She believed that it was an accident.

Maya : Did you see? I was all the way up there, then I was like, Bzzz!

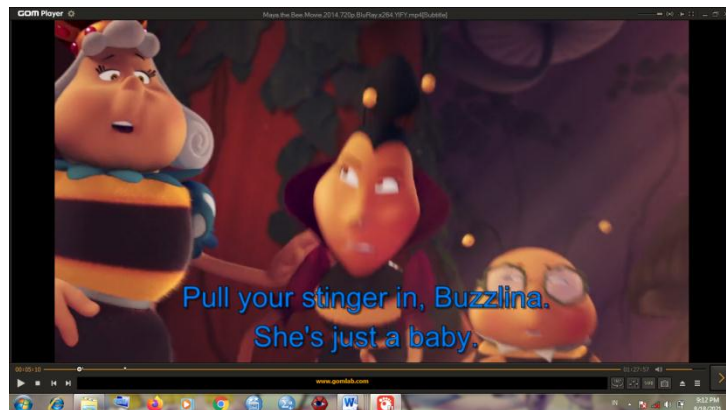
Maya : Miss big Bee, you've something on your head is it heavy?

Queen Bee : ***Pull your stinger in, Buzzlina! She just a baby, I am sure it was an accident.***

In the Queen of bee's dialogue, "***Pull your stinger in, Buzzlina! She just a baby, I am sure it was an accident.***", it can

be present as the value of tolerance. Because in that sentence, Queen of Bee defends Maya, who accidentally made a mistake nearly toppling royal jelly. She believes that it was just an accident and not her fault.

- b. The next value of tolerance shown by the Queen of Bee when hornets scare and provoke all of Bee in the bee hive. This value of tolerance in duration 00.13.23. That can be explicitly transcribed below.

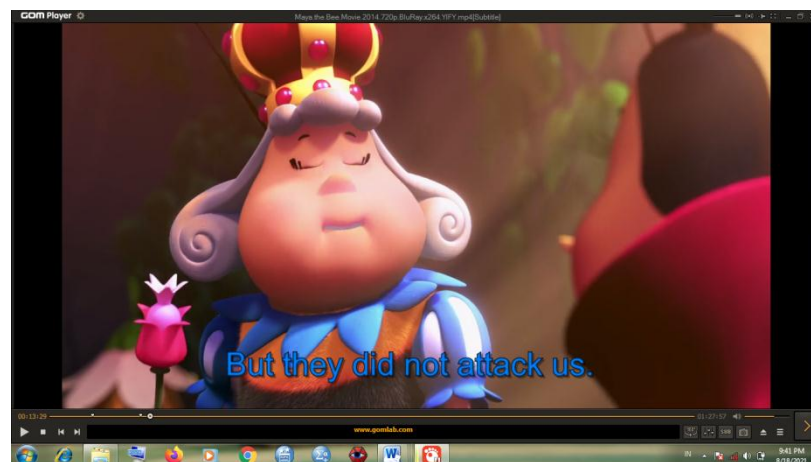
Context: A group of bees worked to collect nectar. When they collected nectar, they met a group of hornets. After that, Buzzlina told the Queen to repel the Hornets, but the Queen said no need to repel them because they did not attack them.

Buzzlina : As the royal adviser, I must strongly advise you to repel the hornets
 Queen Bee : *But, they did not attack us.*

- Buzlina : Well, not yet. But if we let them set up camp, all the other hornet tribe will follow. They will surely turn our meadow into big horrible hornet's nest. They will kill all the flowers and bugs, and then they will eat us. We must show them who is in charge.
- Queen Bee : Remember, I am in charge.

In this dialog, “*But, they did not attack us.*” This dialogue shows the moral value of tolerance because the Queen of Bee thinks that the hornets have no bad intentions toward the Bee. They want to scare and provoke all of Bee in the beehive. So, she does not want to attack the hornets if they do not attack them first. From the context and dialog in the movie, the researcher can conclude that Queen’s attitude shows values of tolerance.

3. Discipline

The following moral value in the Maya the Bee movie that the researcher can find is discipline. Discipline is an attitude or behavior of

respect, obedience to the regulations, both written and unwritten, and carrying them out with great responsibility.

In this movie, the writer only found one value of discipline. Willy's moral value of discipline, in duration 00.21.13 Willy advises the Maya how to be disciplined. That can be explicitly transcribed below.

Context: Maya was banished from the flying training. She made adviser Buzzlina angry at her because she asked too much of her, and she also always answered with an explanation from Buzzlina when she disagreed. One day, when she was in the beehive, she met Willy. She asked Willy how she could fit in this hive. After that, Willy told her that to fit in this hive was easy, to stop asking questions, and follow the orders.

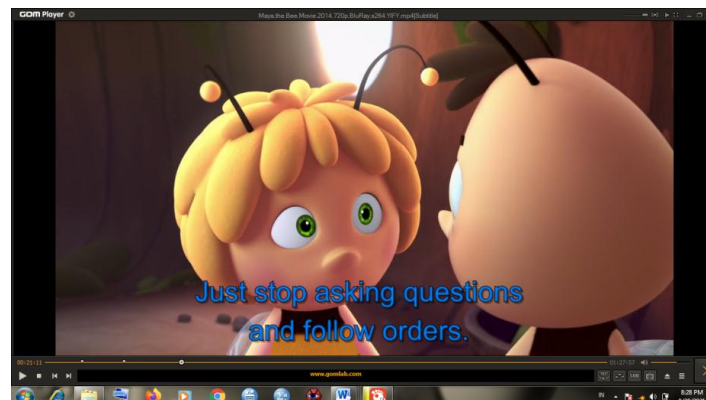
Maya : Huh?

In Willy's dialogue, *"Fitting in is easy. Just stop asking questions and follow orders. That is what the rest of us do, of course, and then you would not be crazy, funny Maya anymore. You will be like every other buzzer."* This dialog represents the value of discipline because Willy asks Maya to stop questioning and follow the orders, to be obedient to the regulations at the hive. So, she will be like the other Bee who do everything as they are ordered to. From the dialogue, the researcher can be concluded that Willy's dialogue shows the value of discipline.

4. Hard Work

In this movie the researcher found two value of hard work. According to Indonesian Law on Permendikbud No. 20 of 2018 hard work is the behavior that shown an effort to solve any obstacle and problem in every situation. Hard work also can be defined as serious attitude to achieve the goals we want. They are as follows.

- a. The value of hard work shown by Maya. In duration 01.08.23 she is taking back the royal jelly from the thief to save the Queen's life. That can be explicitly transcribed below.

Context: Queen Bee was sick because the royal jelly had been stolen. Mrs. Cassandra said the Queen needed the royal jelly. Willy said how they could get the royal jelly back. Sting also said that it is not easy because all hornets' tribes went up against the bee. The

Queen said to bring her to them, but it was too slow. After that, Maya told them she would do it and got the royal jelly back to save the Queen's life.

In Maya's dialogue, "*I will do it. I will go ahead and get the royal jelly. You follow me with the queen.*" This dialogue shows the value of hard work. Because Maya struggles to get back the

royal jelly that Adviser Buzzlina stole to save the Queen of Bees. She also struggles to prevent a war between the Bees and hornets caused by the Buzzlina's slander to the hornets.

From the dialogue above, the writer can be concluded that Maya's dialogue represents the moral value of hard work because she works hard to get royal jelly back and prevent the war between Bees and hornets.

- b. The next value of hard work shown by Maya. In duration 01.14.34 she asks to Bees and Hornets army to working hard together to help Buzzlina and Sting's father. That can be explicitly transcribed below.

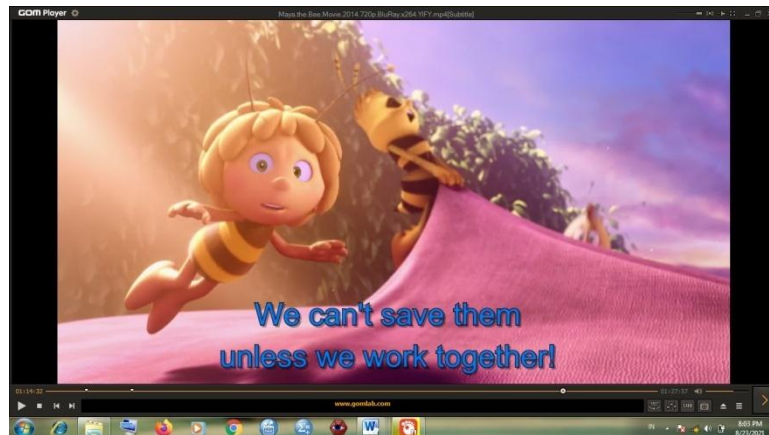
Context: Maya came to the place of war. She told the bee army that royal jelly was not stolen by Hornets but stolen by royal adviser Buzzlina, and she hid it. Then Buzzlina told Bee soldiers not to believe the word of Maya. After saying that, Buzzlina got angry and unknowingly pulled the fragile Gorgo rafting doll so that the Gorgo doll broke and hit Buzzlina and Sting's father. Maya tried to lift the Gorgo doll but, she could not. Maya told all of the bees, hornets, and bugs they could not save Buzzlina and Sting's father if they were not working together. So, they work hard together to lift the Gorgo doll. Finally, both of them can be saved by Maya and others.

From the Maya's dialogue, "*We cannot save them unless we work together! -everybody, grab a piece of Gorgo! -Lift! it is working!*". This dialogue shows the moral value of hard work. The moral value of hard work can be seen when Buzzlina and Sting's dad gets hit by a Gorgo doll. Maya persuades Bees, Hornets, and all the meadow residents to pull the Gorgo doll together. Maya and others work hard to lift the Gorgo. In the end, the Gorgo doll can be lifted so that Buzzlina and Sting's father can be saved because of their hard work.

5. Creativity

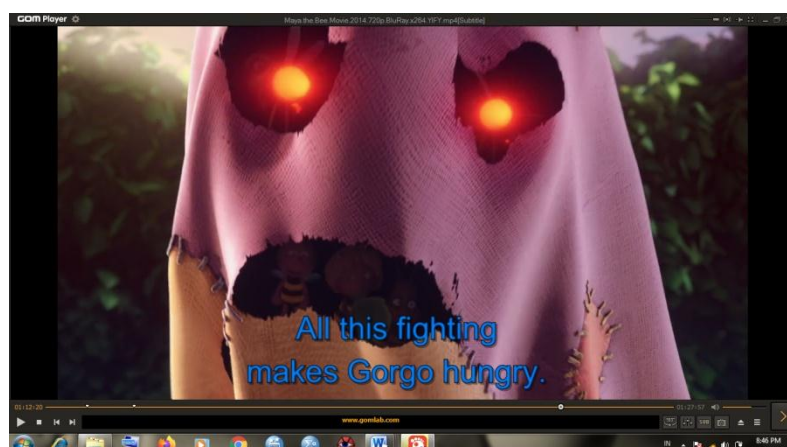
Creativity based on Indonesian law on Permendikbud No.20 of 2018 can be summarized as creative thinking or taking action to create new things in new ways that are different from what other people have done before.

From Maya, the Bee movie as the object in this research, the researcher only found one moral value of creativity. The moral value of creativity can be seen in the duration 01.12.42 by Maya. She makes the replica of Gorgo to prevent a war between Bees and Hornets. That can be.

Context: Maya came to the place of war with her friends. Maya had an idea to make a replica of the Gorgo rafting doll to stop the warfare. Maya and her friends did the rafting doll to move. Maya in the inside of Gorgo replica to stop the war and they must be a friend.

Maya : *Who wakes Gorgo from his sleep? All this fighting make Gorgo hungry.*
 Ant's Squad : Right! Go right! Left!
 Dung Beetles : No, I said the other left!
 Maya : *Naughty Bugs, the meadow belongs to everyone. And hornets be a friend*
 Wily : Gorgo says give bees pollen whenever they are hungry.
 Maya : Wily!

The moral value of creativity shown by Maya with her creativity, Maya created a replica of Gorgo, a straw doll which Bees and Hornets scared with. It can be seen in Maya's dialogue. It can be seen in Maya's dialogue, "*Who wakes Gorgo from his sleep? All this fighting makes Gorgo hungry.*" Furthermore, "*Naughty Bugs, the meadow belongs to everyone. And hornets be a friend*". She uses it to prevent the war between Bees and Hornets, so the war ended without Bees and Hornets clashing (killing/ hurting) each other..

6. Democrat

Based on the Indonesian Law on Permendikbud No. 20 of 2018, a democrat is thinking, behaving, and acting that every person has the same right and obligation. For Example, mutual respect for the rights of fellow citizens, loving each other's family members, do not differentiate between friends in daily interaction, respecting different opinions of friends, etc.

In the Maya, the Bee movie, the researcher found three moral values of the democrat. The moral values can be seen in the duration 00.59.49, 01.13.24, 01.19.01. For more detail, the explanation will explain below as follows.

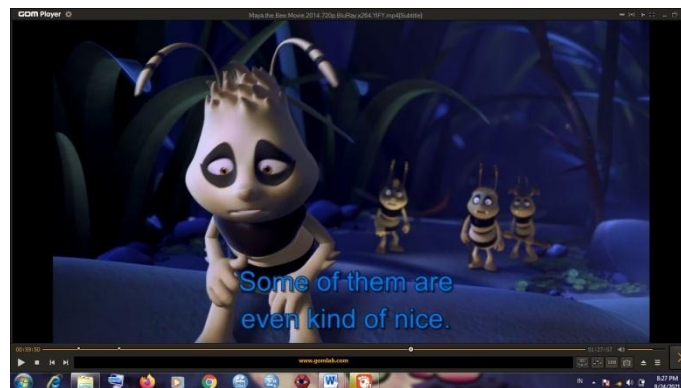
- a. The first moral value of democrat shown by Sting. In duration 00.59.49 Sting says to his hornet friends that not all Bees are bad. That can be explicitly transcribed below.

Context: In the sting house, he was daydreaming, suddenly sting friends came and mocked to sting. Sting's friends said the sting

was a dirty bee monster. After that, sting answered his friend's statement that bees do not suck souls and some of them were very kind of nice.

Sting shows the moral value of a democrat. Sting shows this value of democrat because Sting's way of thinking is that Bees have many kinds of types, not all Bees are nasty Bees, some of them are kind of nice. That can be seen in Sting's dialogue "***-Stop that. - Bees do not suck souls. Some of them are even kind of nice.***" He also thinks that the Bees have the same right as them. From the dialogue above, the researcher concludes that what Sting does represents the moral value of a democrat because he does not discriminate against his friends, and he does not judge that all the Bees are bad like what his hornet friends think.

- b. The second moral value of democrat shown by Maya. She tells to all the Bees and Hornets that they can be friend without discriminating each other. That moral value can be seen in duration 01.13.24. That can be explicitly transcribed below.

Context: When the war between hornets and Bees, Maya and friends came to the place. Sting's dad was shocked because sting was friends with bees. Maya came closer to Wily and sting. She put their hands together and said that bees and hornets could be friends.

Maya shows the moral value of the democrat. This value is shown by Maya when Sting's father saw his son become a friend of Bees. Sting's father says that Bees and Hornets cannot be a friend. Nevertheless, Maya says that Bees and Hornets can be

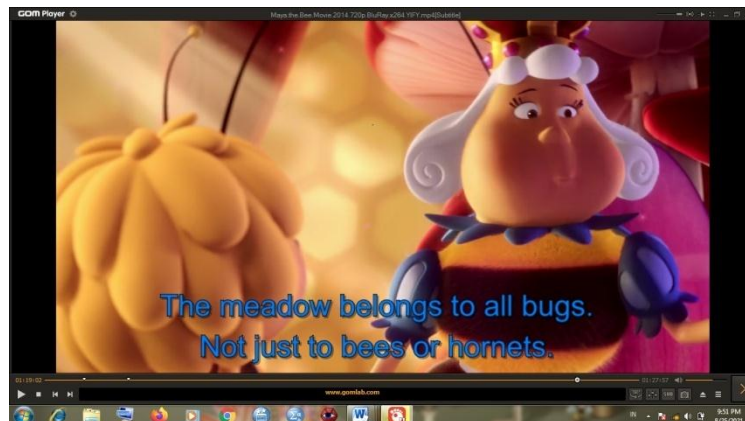
friends, like Maya's dialogue "*No, he has not! Hornets and bees can be friends. Look!*" From the dialogue, the researcher can summarize that Maya's behavior presents the moral value of democrat because she wants to be friends with the Sting, which is a different colony from her, and she also does not discriminate against him.

- c. The last moral value of democrat shown by Queen Bees. In duration 01.19.01 Queen Bees tells that all of the meadow residents have the same right. That can be explicitly transcribed below.

Context: When in a ceremony awarding the Queen made a speech to all the meadow when they were gathering. The Queen told Maya had taught us. That we had a great deal to learn the grassland belongs to all bugs. Not just to bees or hornets, not only for bees or hornets.

- Maya : And I really am a normal little bee?
- Queen Bee : Oh, no. You are a very special little bee.
- Maya : Yes, I fit in.

In the sentence on Queen Bee's dialogue, "*My dear bees, Maya has taught us that we have a great deal to learn the meadow belongs to all bugs. Not just to bees or hornets.*" This dialogue represents the moral value of a democrat. Because what Maya and bugs do make the Queen of Bee realize that everyone is equal. They have the same right and obligations. So, the Queen of Bee concludes that all of the meadows belong to all bugs, all of them are the same, and all of them also have a role to play.

7. Curiosity

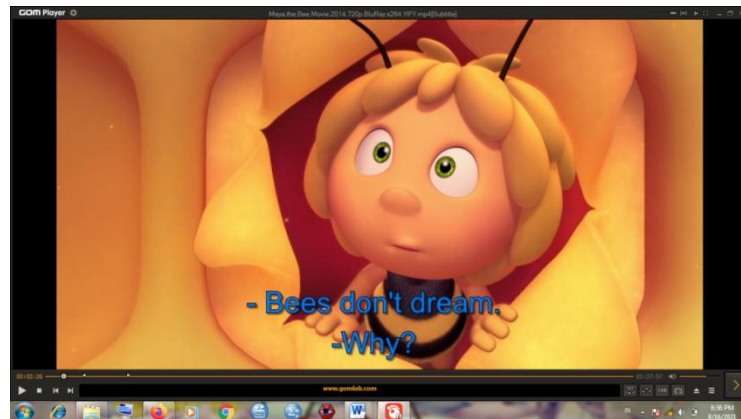
According to Indonesia Law on Permendikbud No. 20 of 2018, curiosity can be defined as attitudes and actions that seek to know more deeply and extend from what they learn, see or hear. From the Maya and the Bee movie, the researcher found five moral values of curiosity. They can be seen in duration 00.02.26, 00.02.36, 00.02.50, 00.05.03, and 00.16.16. A more detailed explanation will explain below as follows.

- a. The first, moral value of curiosity shown by Maya in duration 00.02.26. She asks to the nursemaid and Mrs. Cassandra why Bee does not dream. That value can be explicitly transcribed below.

Context: Maya was a baby bee. She just woke up from her sleep. Mrs. Cassandra knew Maya had woken up walked over to her, but Maya immediately said that Maya was the dream and would tell Mrs. Cassandra about her dream. She let on Mrs. Cassandra about her dream, she said there was the big, bright round yellow thing, and all was blue. When she was telling her dream, the nursemaid came and said that the bee was not dreaming. Maya was confused with her statement. She asked the nursemaid why the bee was not dreaming.

From the dialogue above, the writer got the value of curiosity from Maya. When she woke up from her sleep, and she saw the Nursemaid with Mrs. Cassandra. Maya said to Mrs. Cassandra that she was dreaming. When Maya told about her dream, Nursemaid said to Maya that the bee does not dream. Maya asked the Nursemaid why Bee did not dream. From this dialogue, the value of curiosity can be reflected in Maya's dialogue "**why?**" because Maya's question reflected her curiosity about the Nursemaid statement.

- b. The second moral values of curiosity shown by Maya. Maya's curiosity can be seen in duration 00.02.36 when she curious why she cannot do what she wants. That value can be explicitly transcribed below.

Context: Maya woke up from sleep, and the nursemaid saw her. She came closer and asked her to rest again because bees never

hatch until the sun rises over the daffodils. And then, Maya asked the nursemaid the question of why I could not do what I wanted. Knowing that Mrs. Cassandra came and calmed Maya, there was plenty of time for learning later, said Mrs. Cassandra.

Nursemaid : Now rest, bees never hatch until the sun rises over the daffodils.

Maya : ***Why can't I just do what I want?***

Nursemaid : Bee does what she wants? ohhh

Nursemaid : Patience, little bee. There is plenty of time for learning later

From Maya's dialogue, "***Why can't I just do what I want?***" Shown moral value of curiosity, because from Nursemaid statement she curious why she cannot do what she wants in the beehive. Maya wants to be free, Bee, and she wants to do what she loves to do. From that dialogue, the researchers can be concluded that Maya's question to Nursemaid represents the value of curiosity because her question shows her curiosity why she cannot do what she wants.

- c. The third curiosity shown by Maya. Her curiosity can be seen in duration 00.02.50 when she asks Mrs. Cassandra what a bee is. That value can be explicitly transcribed below.

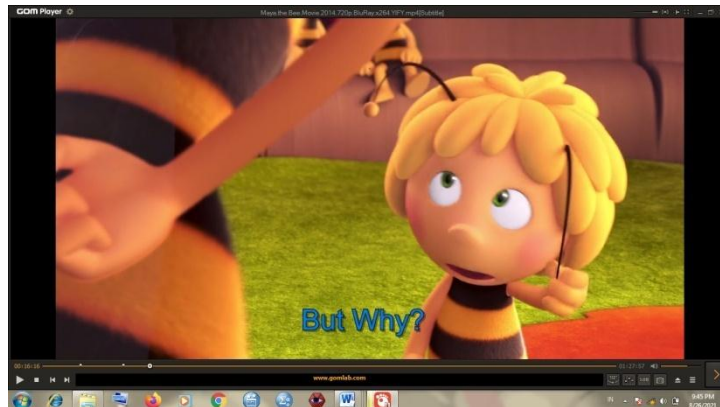

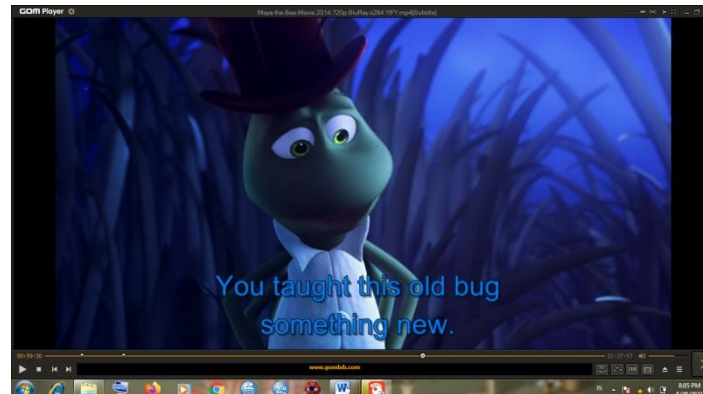
not afraid to the Gorgo because Gorgo is just straw doll. That moral value can be explicitly transcribed below.

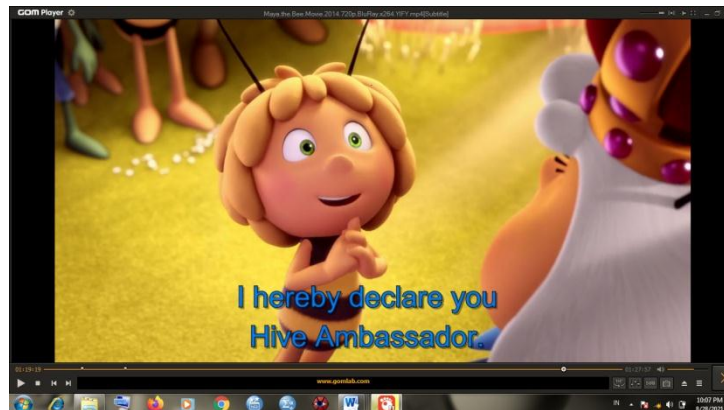

10. Friendliness

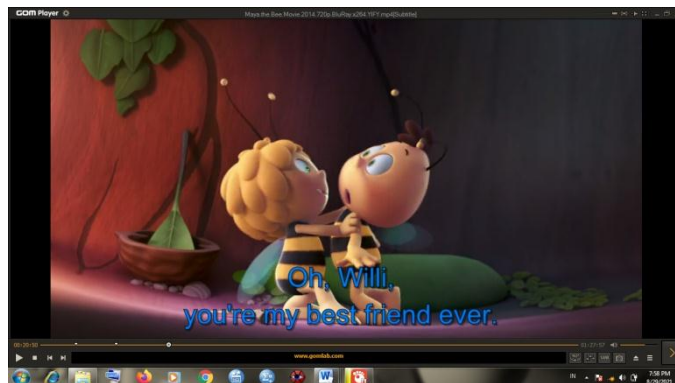

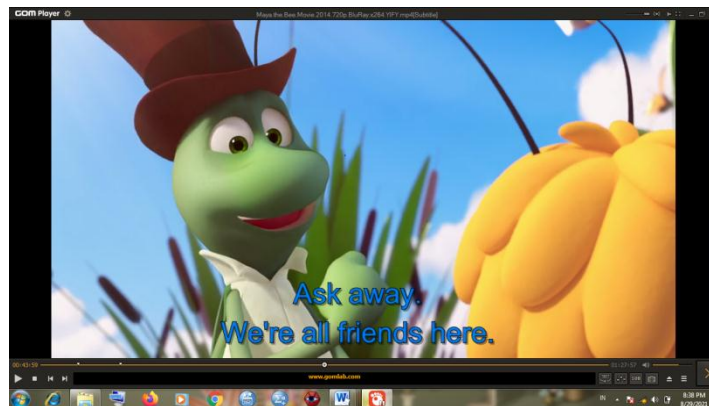
first friend ever.”. That dialogue shows us that both of them have kind-hearted and cooperate with each other.

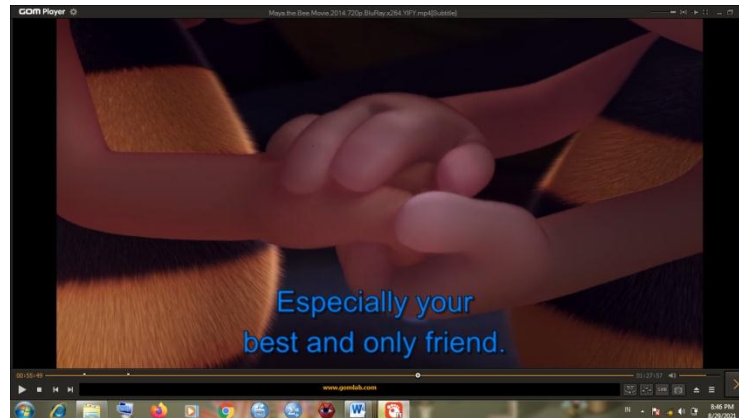

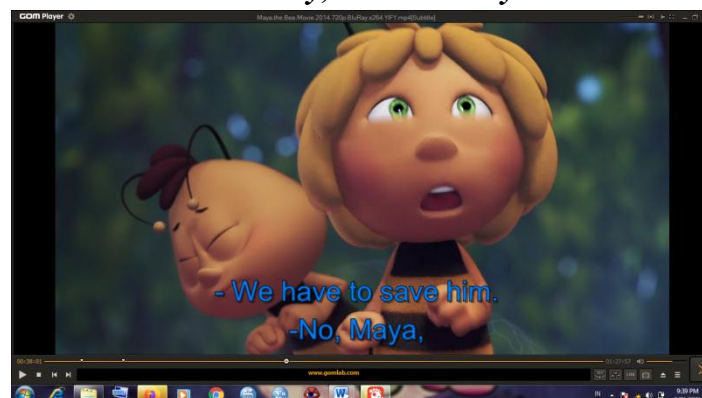

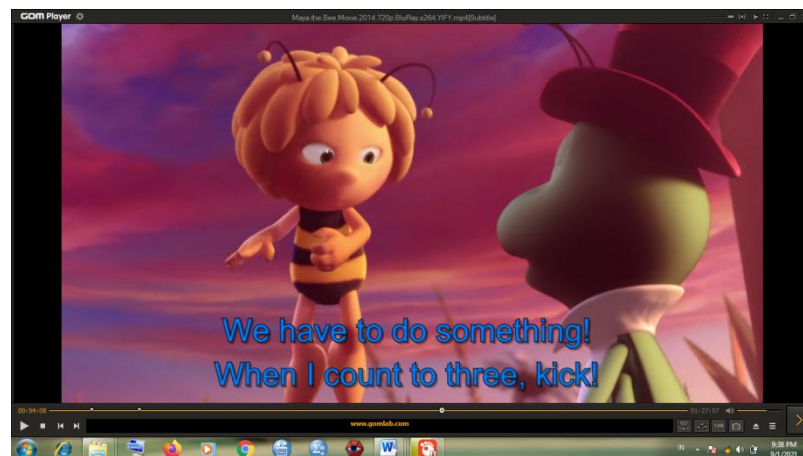
- c. The third moral value shown by Maya. She saves Wily from danger situation when he is almost bitten by a bat. That moral value can be explicitly transcribed below.

Responsibility is the attitude and actions of a person to carry out the duties and obligations we should do towards ourselves, society, and

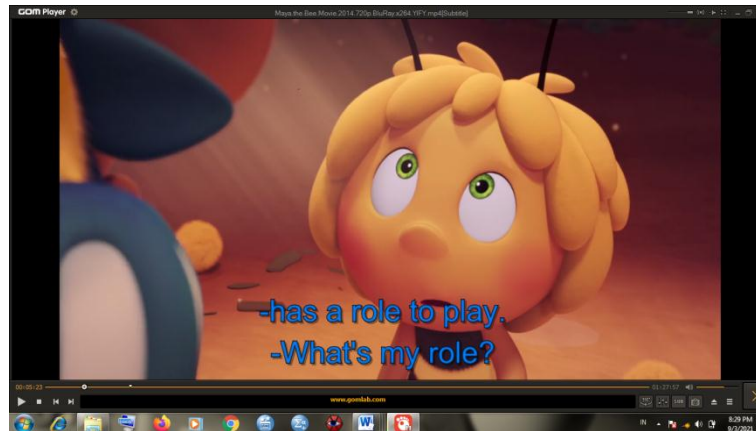

The moral value of responsibility shown by Queen Bee, in duration 00.05.23 the Queen tells to Maya that every Bee has role to play. That moral value can be explicitly transcribed below.

Context: Maya just made such a fuss that made others' bees could not work. This accident made Buzzlina angry with Maya. The Queen ran closer to Buzzlina and Maya.
