

## CHAPTER IV

### RESEARCH FINDING AND DISCUSSION

This chapter presents the result of data analysis that covers the description of the figurative language in Disney's song based on the research questions. It involves the figurative language of the lyrics of Disney songs, the meaning of the figurative language of the lyrics of Disney's songs, and the messages of the song.

#### A. Data and Analysis

In this section, the researcher provides findings of song lyrics analysis. The findings include figurative language type in song lyrics of Disney's movie soundtracks, general meaning, and message in song lyrics of Disney's movie soundtracks.

Figurative Languages Found in Song Lyrics of Disney's Movie Soundtracks After analyzing nine songs of Disney's movie soundtracks, the researcher found several kinds of figurative languages contained in song lyrics. The findings of the analysis are presented as follow:

##### 1. How far I'll Go

## **B. The General Meaning of Lyrics in The Disney's soundtracks movie**

### 1. How Far I'll Go

These lyrics describe the search for the identity of a young girl. The young girl has a different passion from other women in her hometown. How his desires and interests differ from others is the love of nautical. The search for identity was disturbed by doubts because she was different from the others. This didn't stop him from following his conscience to venture out into the far ocean to an unknown place.

*See the line where the sky meets the sea? It calls me  
And no one knows, how far it goes  
If the wind in my sail on the sea stays behind me  
One day I'll know if I go there's just no telling how far I'll go*

These lyrics tell that Moana wants to go around the ocean. he wanted to show that he could go as far as possible around the ocean.

### 2. Let it Go

Tells of a girl who was excommunicated and left her kingdom after her miraculous power was known to many people. Realizing that she does

not need to hide his abilities, she considers herself free from the obstacles she encountered as a child and rejoice at being able to use her powers fearlessly and without limits, to let his past go, and release his powers to make a life of his own.

### 3. Reflection

The lyrics express Mulan's feelings about wanting to show the world who she is, instead of pretending to be her real self, but fearing disappointing her family by doing so. This scene takes place at Mulan's house in the surrounding garden and ends at her family's shrine, where she removes her makeup to reveal her true appearance. Line 9-14.

This lyric means that Merida wants to be known people as a hero. strong like an eagle means she is a strong hero.

#### 5. Try Everything

These lyrics describe someone who often fails but never gives up trying. This person keeps trying until she can achieve what she wants. This statement is supported by these lyrics: Line 41-46

These lyrics about a person, even though he made many mistakes, She did not give up on correcting his mistakes.

#### 6. The Next Right Thing

At the darkest moment of the film, Anna is faced with uncertainty about what to do next after apparently losing both her beloved sister Elsa as well as Olaf, the snowman created by Elsa's magic. She sings "The Next Right Thing" and expresses her depression. Later in the song, she concludes when not knowing to do, one must do "The Next Right Thing". The detailed meaning of I See the Light is presented as follow. Line 1-10

These lyrics show that Anna is scared. She is in a dark place and unable to solve the problem after Elsa and Olaf are gone. She almost gave up on these lyrics. Line 21-31

#### 7. I See The Light

Generally, I See the Light is a song that tells about a journey of a girl named Rapunzel. Rapunzel had an isolated life, she was locked in a remote tower for years. She had a dream to see the floating lanterns and in the end, she could make her dream came true with the help of the second main character named Flynn Rider. This song tells about Rapunzel's dreams which finally could be achieved. The detailed meaning of I See the Light is presented as follow. Line 1-8

*All those days watching from the windows  
All those years outside looking in  
All that time never even knowing  
Just how blind I've been  
Now I'm here blinking in the starlight  
Now I'm here suddenly I see  
Standing here it's all so clear  
I'm where I meant to be*

Those lyrics tell about Rapunzel's life before and after leaving the tower. Rapunzel's life before leaving the tower is very dull and confined.



It is showed in the movie that Rapunzel is isolated in a remote tower. Her knowledge about life is limited which is then expressed as if she was blind in lyrics “just how blind I’ve been”. Furthermore, the lyrics “Now I’m here blinking in the starlight” and “Now I’m here, suddenly I see” tell that Rapunzel’s life changes into a better one after she leaves the tower. The word “starlight” represents the light of thousands of floating lanterns which are compared to starlight. In the movie, it is shown in the scene when Rapunzel and Rider see the floating lanterns. At that time, Rapunzel believes that she has done the right thing by leaving the tower. Line 9-12

Those lyrics above mean that finally Rapunzel can be free and see the beautiful world outside. It is expressed as if “the fog has lifted” which means her loneliness and sorrow finally disappeared while the lyrics “it’s like the sky is new” means Rapunzel her life turns becoming more beautiful and exciting. Line 17-24

Those lyrics above tell about Flynn Rider's point of view. It tells about Rider's life before and after meeting Rapunzel. Before meeting Rapunzel, Rider tries hard to figure out his desire and ambition which is expressed in the lyric "all those days chasing down a daydream" while the lyric "all those days living in a blur" means that Rider lives in great hesitation without direction and guidance. However, after he meets Rapunzel, he gets his new dream which is to be with Rapunzel. At that time, Rider believes that being with Rapunzel is the right thing to do

#### 8. You Got a Friend in me

This song tells about a toy cowboy named Woody who loves his master, Andi. Andi already considers Woody as his best friend. The detailed meaning of You've got a friend in the meeting is presented as follow:

*You've got a friend in me  
You've got a friend in me  
When the road looks rough ahead  
And you're miles and miles from your nice warm bed  
You just remember what your old pal said  
Boy, you've got a friend in me*

These lyrics mean that woody always accompanies Andy no matter how far away from Andi's house. he is still Andi's best friend. Line 10-13

*You got troubles, and I got 'em too  
There isn't anything I wouldn't do for you  
We stick together and we see it through  
'Cause you've got a friend in me*

When Andi has a problem, Woody helps Andi to solve the problem. they solve problems as friends. Line 11-21

*There isn't anything I wouldn't do for you  
We stick together and we see it through  
'Cause you've got a friend in me  
You've got a friend in me  
Some other folks might be a little bit smarter than I am  
Bigger and stronger too, maybe  
But none of them will ever love you the way I do  
It's me and you, boy  
And as the years go by  
Our friendship will never die  
You're gonna see it's our destiny*

These lyrics mean that woody is always there when Andi needs it. These lyrics also show the very big woody affection for Andi. woody said that only he loved andi more than anyone and their friendship would not stop 1.

### **C. The Messages of Lyrics on the Disney's Selected Song**

#### **1. How Far I'll go**

This song has a meaning “Never be afraid to keep moving for our goals to be achieved. Whatever we do today is a life process. This message supported by the lyrics that read.

*See the light as it shines on the sea? It's blinding

The message is “giving up and keep trying to achieve the desired goals. and when you make a mistake. do not give up and correct the mistakes. and start a new life. This message has supported by the lyrics of this song.

'Til I reach the end  
Then I'll start again  
No, I won't leave  
I wanna try everything*

### **7. The Next Righ Thing**

This song has a message “don't rely too much on someone if you can do something yourself. you too can get up and do it yourself.” Because this message related to the lyrics.

*The only star that guided me was you  
How to rise from the floor?  
But it's not you I'm rising for  
Just do the next right thing  
Take a step, step again  
It is all that I can to do  
The next right thing  
I won't look too far ahead  
It's too much for me to take  
But break it down to this next breath, this next step  
This next choice is one that I can make*

## **8. I See The Light**

This song has a message “don't hold back from knowing what you have never known. You need to get out of your comfort zone to see what you have never seen and that you know.” Because this song related to these lyrics.

*All those days watching from the windows  
All those years outside looking in  
All that time never even knowing  
Just how blind I've been  
Now I'm here blinking in the starlight  
Now I'm here suddenly I see  
Standing here it's all so clear  
I'm were I meant to be*

## **9. You Got a Friend in me**

This song has a message “a friend will always be there for friends whenever needed, whatever the reason. So even though we live apart from our friends, we shouldn't forget them. Instead, we have to keep in touch

with them, and care for each other.” This message supported by these lyric.

*You got troubles, and I got 'em too  
There isn't anything I wouldn't do for you  
We stick together and we see it through  
'Cause you've got a friend in me*

#### **D. Discussion**

This discussion describes the data found and analyzed by researchers in the previous chapter. Besides, this discussion also answers the researcher's questions in chapter one. First, this discussion discusses the types of figurative language. Second, it describes the figurative language used in the song lyrics of the Disney soundtrack. After conducting the analysis, the researcher found several types and described the figurative language used in the song lyrics. There are several types of figurative language used in songs such as Thirteen Hyperbole, five Personification, seven similes, two metaphors, two symbols, and one Paradox.

Hyperbole is an exaggerated expression used to express something or a condition in a way that is bigger than usual (Perrine, 1992). In this song, the researchers found more hyperbole that was analyzed. Songwriters use hyperbole to emphasize this statement. Besides, hyperbole is used to exaggerate fact shows, and songwriters use hyperbole to convey strong feelings to attract listeners. Like the lyrics (You fill your heart with love) is Hyperbole, because the sentence is exaggerated and in fact, the heart contains blood cells that cannot be trusted in the body. In this sentence, it means that

the singer wants listeners to have love and happy feelings to face the next obstacle. Other lyrics which are (I will fly Chasing the wind and touch the sky) are also hyperbole. The sentence is also exaggerated. Humans cannot fly. The meaning of these lyrics is that the singer wants to achieve his wish.

In determining the meaning we have to know what the writer will say. Pateda (2001: 81) explains that the meaning of language also varies when viewed from different points of view. From the perspective of the researcher, the implied meaning of the above example is that heaven has been given to me. In the semantic sense above, it can be classified into connotative meaning.

Every lyric written must have a message aimed at both the listener and the reader. The message was directed with the intention that they would get an impression after listening to and reading the lyrics. Based on this theory, "messages are the things that singers want to convey to listeners and readers through their songs". Thus, the message contained in Disney's Soundtracks movie lyrics is indirectly conveyed to listeners and readers through the lyrics they write. We can find the lyric message after we know the meaning contained in it.

The lyrics of Disney's selected songs try to tell you about life which contains love, sadness, happiness, and passion. In Disney's selected song lyrics that contain figurative language is very helpful in understanding the song. The existence of figurative language is not to make it difficult to understand lyrics but to simplify and clarify understanding of lyrics. The song



is perfect for English Learners who want to improve their English skills in analyzing lyrics that contain figurative language. From the description above, it can be concluded that in analyzing the lyrics in addition to finding figurative language in the lyrics, we can also understand the meaning of the song which contains figurative language and the message of the song.
