### **CHAPTER IV**

#### RESEARCH FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS

The data were based on selected songs lyric from Tjahjadi Djajanata. The song sare transcribed in appendix. The data analysis is in the form of per-song one by one. The discource analysis is based on gramatical cohesion and lexical cohesion such as, refference, repetition synonymy and so on. The data is intended to put into the table for the purpose of make easier to read. Interpretation from each songs was written following in the data analysis.

### 1.1 Finding

### 1.2.1 Grammatical cohesive device

Based on the finding that found by the researcher, the important part in finding the representation is on the using of person pronoun in the text. Resercher used the theory of Sara Mills about the position of subject and object in the text which will take the important role of the legitimate and illegitimate one. She was concern on how woman was presented in the text of positioning subject and object in the discourse in depict into using of pronoun. Based on the text analysis of the data implied domination of using "Aku/gue" or "I" rather than "Kamu/kau/elo" or "You", singer or the speaker of the text which become the subject of those discourse is woman. Then singer of those songs is the message deliver from the song writer, but in those text implied that the text was created by the singer as long as they take role's subject of the text. Singer which do not have power in create those discourse

automatically agree to the creator of the discourse even though the singer which is woman is presented such in the discourse that brought by themselves. The singer is unconsciously beome illegitimate one who could not present herselves in the text. She just be appeared in the text as the pronoun "aku or gue" significantly. The song's writer is a man who has power in producing the discourse. But in the whole song the writer depicted woman based on their own prespective or ideology about woman. Based on the data woman is pictured as the one that so vulgar with her sex experience pictured in cinta satu malam and mojok di malam jum'at, such an easy in break the norm in Hamil Duluan, easy to make affair in EGP and gajaman, such aggressive depict in Godain Kita Dong. Woman tends to be object of consumerism, which the discourse which pictured their negative side. They used by the powerful one for their own interest. Feminism Marxis was concern on this, woman and the object in capitalism (Tong, 2009:98)

### 1.2.2 Lexical cohesive device

Resercher interpreted song which presented woman and thir representation in the discourse based on the word or sequence of the word that significantly appear in the discourse. Representation is divide into three steps first one is encode, then the process of depicted a woman in the discourse and the last on is decode of reality (Eriyanto, 2001:114). Representation that contain in all song that used as data by the researcher. Representation also can be seen word choice as the creator whithin partisipant of the text (Fairclough, 2001: 133)

- a. The first song is Cinta Satu Malam which is sang by Melinda. The title that was chosen by the writer was depicting the whole of the discourse. That song is about a woman and her love experience. The lyric is contains a lot of desire of love can be infer by the word "Yang ku rasa hanya indahnya cinta, hasratku kian membara". The word choice of those utterence in this song is so identical with desire of having sex experience.
- b. Second song is Hamil Duluan which sang by Tuty Wibowo. Woman depict quite clear in this song, that's her sex experience with her boyfriend. Hamil duluan which means pregnancy without get married describe woman as the the one that can not resist those desire. The writer chooses some vivid word and sequence of event up to happen her pregnancy. The consumer of this second song was constructed to the reality that woman was so easy in make such that mistake come from the smallest thing.
- c. The next song was Emang Gua Pikirin or abbreviated with EGP. The love. Singer is picture as the woman who did not trust with her partner in love. Her partner is make affair with other woman and the singer dare to be did the same thing that is made affair with more than one man or get revenge drawn as "elo punya gebetan baru gua juga bisa gitu" and "gua juga punya cowok yang lain" The reality that might be constructed that woman is tried to expend an equal position with a man, in the context of this discourse is about a relation. A woman also can have another secret lover so did a man done.

- d. The third song the fourth song under the title aku mah apa atuh draw a woman who become an affair by a man. She told about her broken heart because of the ignorance by the man. She also depicted that the man was let given lot pain to her because she saw her man get kissed with other woman in front of her. This song constructed a reality that woman is so easy to be fooled by the man, in such unfair relationship. It can see crystal clear in the word "aku mah apa atuh cuma selingkuhan kamu".
- e. Come into Mojok di Malam Jumat as the fifth song this song is about woman who was missing her lover. She asks her boyfriend to come although in the Thursday night, when Thursday is an uncommon day in getting date in Indonesian. The singer also describes her willing of getting sex it can infer from the utterance "cumbulah aku sesukamu". This song tried to make a reality that although in the eastern especially Indonesia there is such taboo to do such skin ship with a man who not her husband but that was so common in these day to doing that. It also can indicate the allowance of doing such free sex in this society.
- f. Go on for the sixth song that is Jamur which abbreviation from Janda Bawah Umur. Here the singer as the subject as the song is woman again. Woman in this song is told to the discourse consumer about her divorce, that the singer is got divorce in such young. Those songs told about the pain of her experience after she got married. She got dumped by her husband who depict from the utterance"Aku dicampakkan, aku ditelantarkan Aku berantakan, aku kau

- ceraikan" The song is tried to construct a reality that woman is the powerless group which luck the power around society. She tends to be scathing her own decision in getting married.
- g. The seventh song is Jangan Gila Dong. The song was encoding woman who tried to cheer other woman when they broke up with her boyfriend. She asked her boyfriend to move on soon because there is so much other guy. The description is on utterance "Cari aja cowok lain biar enggak nyiksa batin". The song constructs a reality that in the relationship between man and woman, woman inclined tobe the one who got down when they two had broken up.
- h. The eight song, Godain Kita Dong. This song was about woman's desire to get a lover. It depicts crystal clear in this song. Almost the whole song repeated the same utterence "godain kita dong, rayuin kita dong, pacarin kita dong". Resercher also can instantly reffered into woman because the song surely used "cowok". The reality that might be constructed a woman who could not be in the loneliness for long time. Woman was tend to be got lover instead it doesn't love as the basis of their relationship.
- Next song is SakitnyaTuh Disini. This song is the picture of woman who has
  so powerless between men in one relationship. Woman is so close to be the
  one that got deceited by a man.
- j. The last song, Gak Jaman, is quite different from others. Here, the subject as the woman was notice as the person who wants to resist the domination of man. Drawn on the utterance"Aku wanita masa kini, tidak dijajah laki-laki".

Woman here tried to declare herselves with the freedom, but the freedom here was depicting negatively based on the utterence "aku wanita masa kini, kupunya pacar sana-sini". It means that that the one of the freedom measurement by the woman was on the way in got more than one lover.

The person pronon in this analysis was intend to show the possition of woman in the text as the subject of discourse. Altough, in the fact those discourse was not represent woman as it should because they do not have chance to represented themselve as they are.
