### **CHAPTER IV**

# FINDING AND DISCUSSION

The purpose of this chapter is to presents the conflict faced by the main character and also to explain the main character's conflicts built in the plot of Haunted: Possession novel by Lee Mountford.

# A. Finding

The findings were concerned about types of conflict used in the main characters of Haunted: Possession novel by Lee Mountford. This part presents the data that relates to the research questions.

# 1. The Main Character's Conflicts Found in Haunted Novel

In general, conflict refers to dissimilarities in opinion or clash of action from the characters. Whereas Jones (1990:3) distinguishes conflict into three groups, those are psychological conflict, sociological conflict, and physical conflict. In this study, those three conflicts were found.

# a. Psychological Conflict

Psychological conflict happens when a character struggles against himself such as his guilt, conscience, or his own desire. The following are the data from psychological conflict found in " Haunted: Possession novel":

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'I feel nauseous,' Sarah replied. 'It came over me as soon as we approached.' That was both concerning and also encouraging. It meant they were likely on to something, though Luca wasn't quite sure how he felt about that. 'Anything like what you felt at Perron Manor?' David asked. Sarah shook her head. And how can a human not wearing anything in his body and also fulfilling his body with excrement, It's disgusting.

#### Datum 4

# Datum 6

# **b.** Physical Conflict

# Datum 4

Sarah didn't want to hurt someone again because of her. As we know in the Perron Manor, she still thinks that she lost her friends because of her fault.

# Datum 11

As shown in the narration, "Anger and desperation start to bubble up from within her", Sarah who does not believe Father Hus's words about Chloe's turned to be a little curious about this truth. But it makes her even more frustrated, if Chloe is alive, then where is she now.

## Datum 12

In utterance **"I'll wield my fist straight through his fucking head if he says anything like that again"**, Sarah is very angry and her patience was really at its peak until she dared to threaten back him. She couldn't stand his statement about Chloe anymore. She doesn't want to believe in that anymore.

# Datum 13

As stated in utterance, "Jesus f\*cking Christ!" the word f\*ck in that phrase is a word that is always inserted to indicate that she is cursing. She cursed in shock because of that loud voice. In addition, the sentence "She quickly brought a hand to her chest in fright" is a result of that incident, her fear returned again. She is afraid of the devil comes to hurt them.

As stated in utterance, 'JESUS CHRIST,' David was shocked about Father Hus's condition until he call his God. He did not expect about Father Hus's condition. It can be seen from his words of surprise. Whereas before he also saw how Father Hus was in possession, but this time it was really tragic.

### Datum 15

In utterance, **"Fight it!"**, indicates that Father Janosch wants to help her in controlling her emotion, Sarah has difficulty in controlling it. She lost control too easily because of her anger. The action from Father Jansoch was right, if he doesn't do this it will be worst.

### Datum 16

As stated in utterance, "What the f\*ck!" Sarah didn't expect that she is a liar, Sarah is really surprised until she cursed loudly. Beside of this, the utterance of Luca, "It can't be" stated that he also does not expect it. During this time, Sister Maria act like a normal person and she is a kind person who support their investigation.

#### Datum 17

As shown in the narration, **"He was immobilised with fear"** indicated that Sister Maria was so strong, until successfully make Luca scared and confused to take a step. The devil can hurt them without touching them. He does not know how to against them.

As shown in the narration, **Sarah quickly scrambled forward and threw herself over to the far wall, spinning as she did to look back at the horrifying man,** explained that she shocked and panic because of his appear. Sarah quickly stay away from the ghost while also keeping a watchful eye on him.

# Datum 19

The narration by author, **"Sarah screamed aloud again and swung open the door behind her before running through and slamming it shut"** indicates that immediately she wants to escape from that horrible devil. She also feels depressed because no matter how far she runs, the devil will always follow her.

# Datum 20

The utterance **"I'll f\*cking kill you,"** indicates that she is really tired of him. It is because the main conflict that happens in this story is between Sarah and the devil. She was furious at him until he cursed him with extremely cruel words.

# Datum 21

As shown in utterance, "Sarah, no!' Father Janosch shouted in panic". Explained that Father Janosch didn't want Sarah to lose control of her emotions. because it could be fatal. He wasn't sure how much of her aggression was born from natural anger, and how much was a result of the unnatural influence. So, calmness is needed in this situation.

As stated in utterance, "**Back, I tell you!**" explain that Luca said to the devils to get out from the priest and Sister Maria through exorcism. He got angry and shouted at them to stop taking over human bodies. This is not their place because their place is in hell.

### c. Sociological Conflict

Sociological conflict happens when the character's placed in the opposite with society, the government, culture, and another side. The following are the data of sociological conflicts in "Haunted: Possession novel", there are:

# Datum 1

As shown in the utterance, **"That's... that's sick!"** described that Sarah is shocked about the Church building facts. They think that it is customary and beautiful art. In the other perception, Sarah thinks that it's inhuman. The skulls are exhibited like an ornament and each skulls didn't have an identity.

### Datum 2

As stated in utterance, "It's sick" explained that Sarah has opposite ideas from their culture. She thinks that it's unnormal. If they think that it is normal because of art, Sarah still does not believe that they have the heart to do that inhuman thing.

### 2. The Main Character's Conflicts Built in the Plot of Novel

The plot is a sequence of incidents that can build up the story. The plot is an intellectual formulation about the relationships existing among the incidents of a drama or a narrative (Holman 336). Each event was connected like a pattern, because of this the readers will be more understand the story through the plot. The plot also has a important rule for building the character's conflict. The researcher will divide the plot into five stages based on Pickering and Hoeper (1981), there are exposition, complication, climax, falling action, and resolution.

### a. Exposition

The first stage begins with introducing the characters, setting, and other background information. The beginning conflict is started with the conflict between Sarah and her ex-team. Before in Chillingham Castle, they were doing an investigation at Perron Manor. There is an accident which is the reason of the member out. Sarah has accidentally killed David's sister. It is happen when she had been possessed and her action was influenced by demon. Although David understands the situation, the other member is not and decides to go from the group.

In the next investigation on Chillingham Castle, she tries to find the over there and she meets the ghost of boy. The ghost said that there is someone in the darkness following her, whereas only there are both of them in there. This makes the ghost scared and gone. There is the dark spirit that followed her since that investigation, the tragedy starts from here.

### b. Complication

Sarah and her new team are requested by Bishop Turnbull to investigate the cathedral in the town of Kutná Hora, Czech Republic. Actually, they accept the order because the person who possessed said that he know about Sarah and Perron Manor whereas he had never met her. However, the real purpose of this investigation is not to save him, but they want to find the Hell Doorway. In the beginning, they are welcomed by a friendly nun named Sister Maria. She is the kind person who always helps them to cure Father Hus.

As soon as Sarah entered the entrance door, she feel nauseous and it is happen while she was there. Her feeling is influenced by paranormal activity, but it is completely different from previous investigations. The condition of Father Hus is very concerned. He was always mad, say rude, act like an animal, he was also naked even Sister Maria found him pleasuring himself. Apparently, sometimes Father Hus is conscious, which means that he can still be saved. In addition, the demon not only disturbs Sarah's team but also the oldest nun named Sister Agatha. Father Hus threatens her that he will pull out her eyes.

The demon controlling Father Hus is the monk named Herman. He already write down her own satan bible called Codex Gigas. The whole

purpose of this book is worship to the devil. There are some pages of Codex Gigas which lost. They assume that these pages are about Devil's Prayer and have the aim to open the doorway of Hell.

### c. Climax

Sister Maria is a person who always supports them the fact is she is a liar. She is Herman's person. Sister Maria is possessed by devil too. Whereas she acts like a normal person, it makes them a shocked. The other shocking fact is the devil's prayer still continues in the past until now. It's the reason why Sarah always feels nauseous when in the cathedral. Then, they are fighting each other until Sarah is unconscious. When she wakes up, she tries to find an emergency aid to help her team although she feels weak. Shockingly, she found a lot of piled human corpses that is out of space.

In the hallway, she discovers Sister Agatha's body laying on the cold floor. The poor nun wasn't dead, considering the lacerations on her naked body and her eyes were gone. Actually, she didn't want to leave her but she have to find help. Sarah is still being chased by demon, the demon scared her so that she is unable to help them. When she in the ground floor, she has to fight Father Hus and Sister Maria. She was helped by David and Father Janosch, even though they were exhausted from the previous fight. They should stop the devil's prayer which aims to open the hell's doorway.

# d. Falling action

After all the chaos of the fight, Father Hus is already conscious. He was terrified of Sister Maria's condition. They want to go out of this hell place but they need to do an exorcism on Sister Maria. They worried that she will continue the Devil's Prayer with her blood. Thankfully after the exorcism, the demon leaves her body because they see that there is a pool of light-grey liquid spread out beneath her. Although she is not aware yet, she still alive. They had succeeded, and both of the devils had been successfully exorcised. Then, Sister Agatha was carried to a hospital. They need to hide this fact from the public, they didn't want to cause mass panic.

#### e. Resolution

On the next day, Father Janosch has a meeting with the council. The fact is they are not disappointed with their performance but they didn't expect Sister Maria is possessed in the first place. The condition of the church is still close to public, but then everything is already cleared up. The latest condition Sister Agatha is still in the hospital. She doesn't talk much and is in a constant state of fear because lost her sight. Afterward, Father Hus and Sister Maria decided to work there again. In the middle of the night, suddenly Sister Maria knocking the priest's door. She wants to talk with him. Suddenly, she is on top of him, forcing him to lay on the floor with her hands around his throat. The sharp nails of her thumbs pierce the flesh and pull it apart. Unfortunately, he is unable to scream, and finally he died.
