CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

This chapter discuss about background of the study, formulation of research question, purpose of study, significance of study, the definition of key terms, and scope and limitation.

A. Context of the Study

Learning English is very important since English being an International Language. Many sources of learning material in internet are written in English, so if we mastered in English we can learn and enrich our knowledge easily. There are two kinds of communications that commonly use to interact with others they are speaking and writing. In Indonesia teaching English is focused on the ability of student's communication in oral and written form. Writing isone of the most difficult skill to learn especially for foreign language students. It is because students need to consider many linguistics aspect as grammar and vocab. As a foreign language in Indonesia English has been taught from elementary school until university level.

An entire approach to the implementation of a concept, planning, and execution of an action within a specific time frame is known as strategy. In the field of education, a strategy is a plan, method, or set of actions aimed at achieving a specific educational goal. As a result, a learning strategy is a plan that consists of a series of actions aimed at achieving specific educational objectives. The learning strategy may also be defined as the method and manner in which the teacher will teach by defining the primary teaching steps.

In the context of teaching, Sabri Ahmad (2007), state that the strategy is intended as a teacher's effort in creating an environment system that enables the teaching process so that the learning objectives that have been formulated can be achieved and succeeded. As a result, a teacher must be able to organize the

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components of learning in general, as well as the connected function of the learning components in question.

Strategies used by teacher in teaching may influence students learning behaviour. Kara (2009) stated that attitudes towards learning besides opinions and beliefs have an obvious influence on students' behaviours and consequently on their performance. From that statement we can conclude that those students who possess positive beliefs about language learning have a tendency to develop more positive attitudes towards language learning. Positive attitudes of language students specifically can help motivate students to improve strategies or behaviour including ways of language learning to beeffective, this will affect the language learning process.

Hedge states that writing is more than producing accurate and complete sentences and phrases. Writing is about guiding students to: "produce wholepieces of communication, to link and develop information, ideas or arguments for a particular reader or a group or readers..." (2005:10). According to Zemach and Islam writing is the most difficult skills to learn especially for foreign language students. It is because students need to consider many linguistic aspects as grammar and vocabulary. These points make the teaching of writing a complex matter, as all of these this must be considered for efficient learning of writing strategies. For teacher, the implementation of a certain strategy in teaching writing is necessary to do. Choosing the appropriate strategy enables teacher and students to achieve the learning objectives.

Strategies in teaching writing is worth studying because the previousresearch that conducted by Astrini and friends entitled *The Model of Strategies Employed by English Teachers in Teaching Writing Skill in National Plus Schools* stated that the teacher should activate the worth experiences to achieveteaching strategies that are suitable for students. The other previous research conducted by Rifky Dora Wijayati entitled *Shared Writing Strategy in Teaching Writing* suggested the researcher to observe more detailed each strategy that used by the teacher also investigate the aspect of implementation of the strategy.

Based on the explanation above the researcher interested to explore what are strategies used by the teacher in teaching writing, due to the usage of strategy have important role to facilitate students understand in making writing text. Writing are the application of student's look, listen, think, and read, so here the researcher think that strategies is important in teaching learning activity. Beside exploring the strategies that used by teacher in teaching writing the researcher also investigate what factors motivate teachers in using strategies for teaching writing.

The researcher conduct the research in MTsN 8 Blitar. MTsN 8 Blitar is one of the school that has many achievements both academic and non- academic. This school is also a research-based school by the research themes are related to problems in the teaching and learning process, local school curriculum development, learning assessment, and school management. During the internship that the researcher did at MTsN 8 Blitar, the researcher had a conversation about teaching writing with one of the English teachers there because based on the researcher's observations on some students' writing. The result of their writing are understandable and well structured, it's just that there might be a grammatical error. Teacher shared several strategies used to teach writing. The teacher said that if students are taught to write without any strategy used by her, the students' writing result are far from what was expected.
