CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

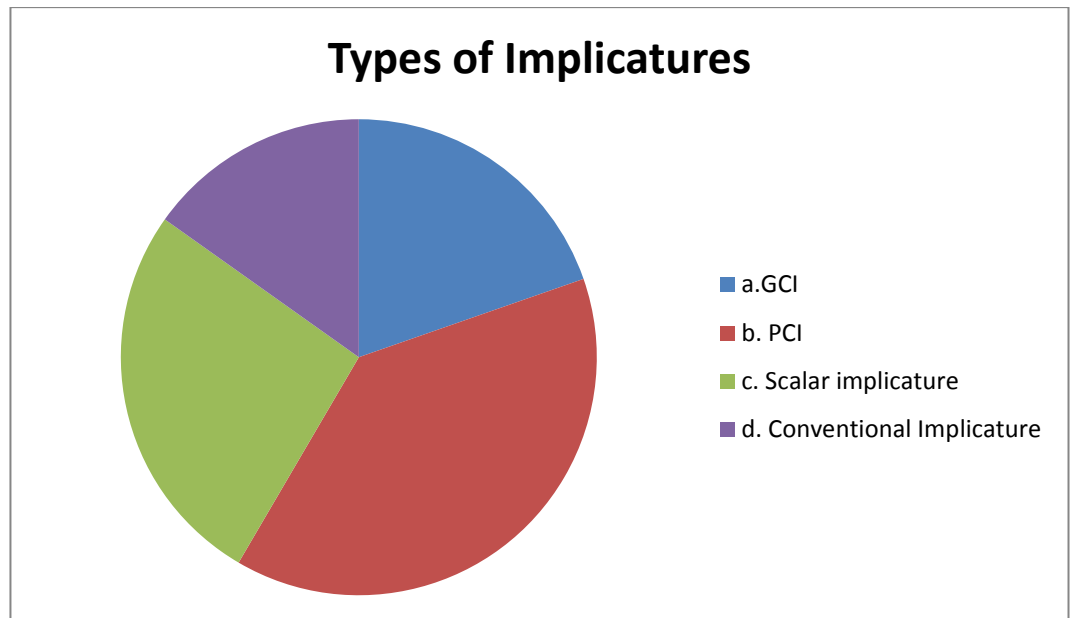
A. Conclusions

Having analyzed the data, the writer found 178 implicature that appears from the utterances of the characters in the movie. Findings of this study reveal that the Implicatures are produced almost as many by the characters in “In Time” movie.

From the result of the analysis the writer can draw several significance conclusions. The writer finds through the analysis of frequency in “*In Time*” movie that there are 178 implicature. The frequency of each types of implicature 35 or 19.66% included into Generalized Conversational Implicatures, 69 or 38.76% included into Particularized Conversational Implicatures, 47 or 26.40% included into scalar implicature, and 27 or 15.17% included into Conventional implicature by the characters in ‘In Time’” movie.

Besides that, the writer can also conclude that the difficulties to analyze the data in the utterance and interpretation intended the meaning.
