Editor and Reviewer comments:

Reviewer 1: I am pleased to have the opportunity to review this research paper entitled "A Parental Guidance Patterns in the Online Learning Process during the Covid-19 Pandemic: Case Study in Indonesian School" - HELIYON-D-22-10826. Although the topic of this research study is interesting and fits within the journal scope. I think authors should apply the comments indicated below to increase the quality of research. The manuscript knows lacks in scientific style and structure.

1. At the end of the Introduction section, it would be good to present the purpose of the research, the novelty of the research, the usefulness of research for various stakeholders. You can also present the structure of the article. What is the originality of this research? Paper research gap and originality should be better presented at the end of introduction section.
2. I recommend using the analysis using VOSviewer in the literature review section. A literature review section is needed to present the current state of research on Online Learning Process.
 - * The analysis is insufficient using only the Google scholar database, I recommend extending the analysis to databases such as: Web of science, Scopus.
 - * Using VOSviewer you can perform the following types of analyzes: Analytics of publication metrics, Analytics of citation metrics, Analytics of hybrid metrics, Coauthorship analysis, Co-citation analysis, Bibliographic coupling, Co-word (or keyword co-occurrence) analysis.
 - * This section needs to be well documented. The state of international research on the online education system needs to be analyzed.
3. I recommend in the results section the statistical analysis of the distributed questionnaires.

4. I recommend creating a discussion section. Discussion needs to be a coherent and cohesive set of arguments that take us beyond this study in particular and help us see the relevance of what authors have proposed. Author needs to contextualize the findings in the literature and need to be explicit about the added value of your study towards that literature. Also, other studies should be cited to increase the theoretical background of each of the method used. Findings should be contextualized in the literature and should be explicit about the added value of the study towards the literature.

5. The discussion section needs to be expanded. In the Conclusions section you need to add: Managerial Implication, Practical/Economical/Social Implications, Limitations, and future research perspective.

6. Questions to be answered:

6.1. What practical/professional and academic consequences will this study have for the future of scientific literature (theoretical contributions)?

6.2. Why is this study necessary? should make clear arguments to explain what the originality and value of the research. This should be stated in the final paragraphs of introduction and conclusion sections.

7. The article must be internationalized. What is the usefulness of the article at international level?

Currently, I recommend a major revision of the article.

I wish success to the authors in the process of reorganization and improvement of the article.

Reviewer 2: Methods: This section must be improved. Discuss in detail the following: research design (what methods are used, justify why they are used); data collection (what instruments are used, reliability and validity of research instruments, date of data collection, location, scope, inclusion criteria, questions asked, etc), data analysis, ethical considerations (ethics committee approval if available, confidentiality, anonymity, etc).

Results: Table 1 must be improved by updating the list of studies and number of citations. There are missing studies on the role of parents in online learning during the pandemic. Either set the number of studies (e.g. 20-25 studies) or set the citations (at least 10) and justify the choice. The results should be discussed.

In connection to the methods, how did the authors analyze the data and arrive at the results in Table 2?




