My sun rises. It always rises in the east.

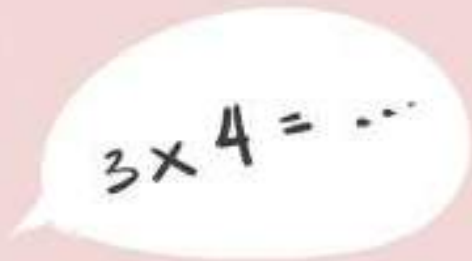
It never rises in the west. However, it

Sleeping alone

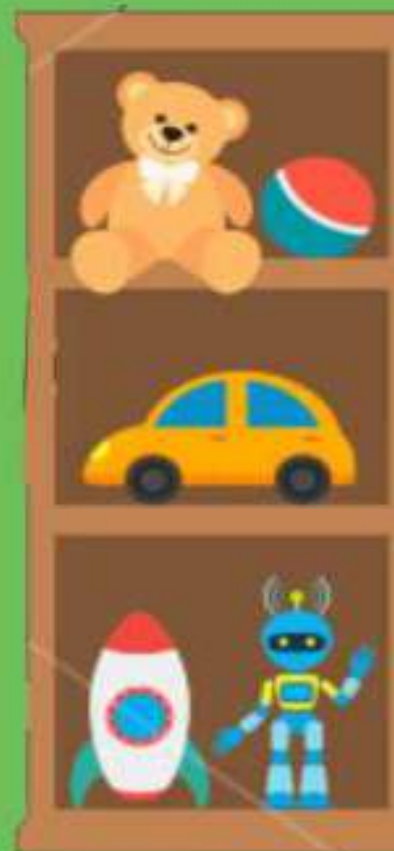
When I was baby, I was sleeping with my father and my mother. Now I am 4 years old. I can sleep alone in my bedroom. I have some toys and story books in my bedroom.

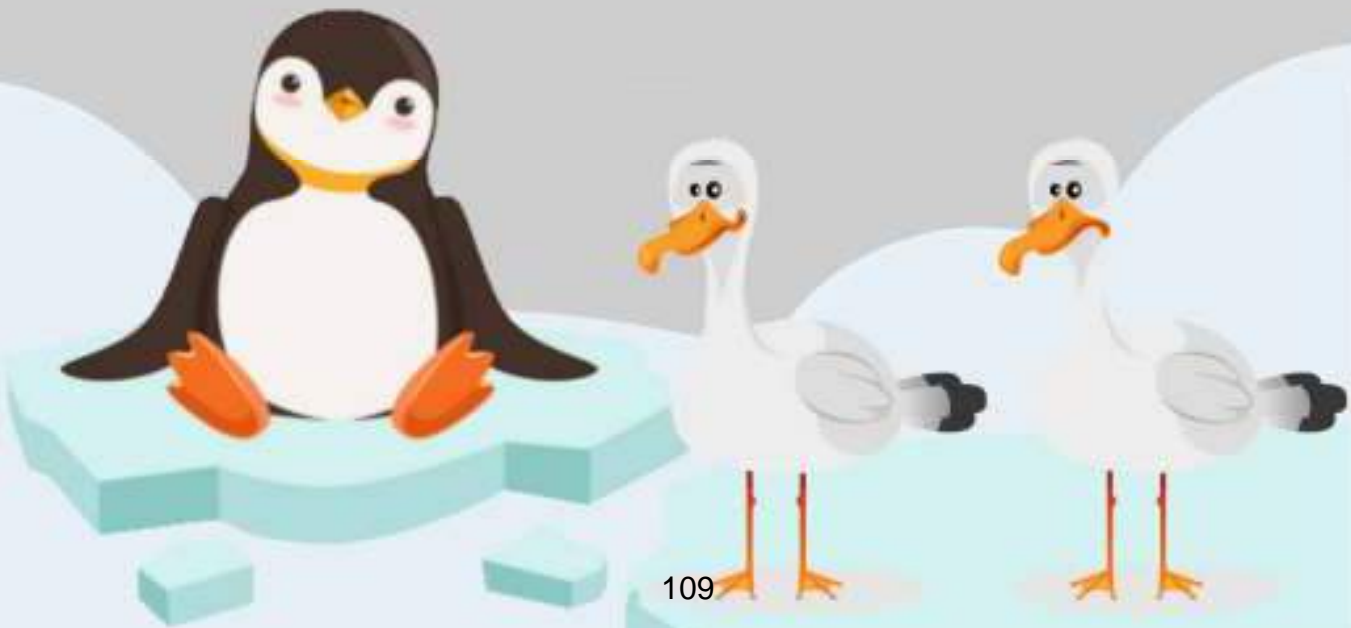
Seagull : "Hi Penguin, why can you do everything by yourself?"

Nini : "Come on."

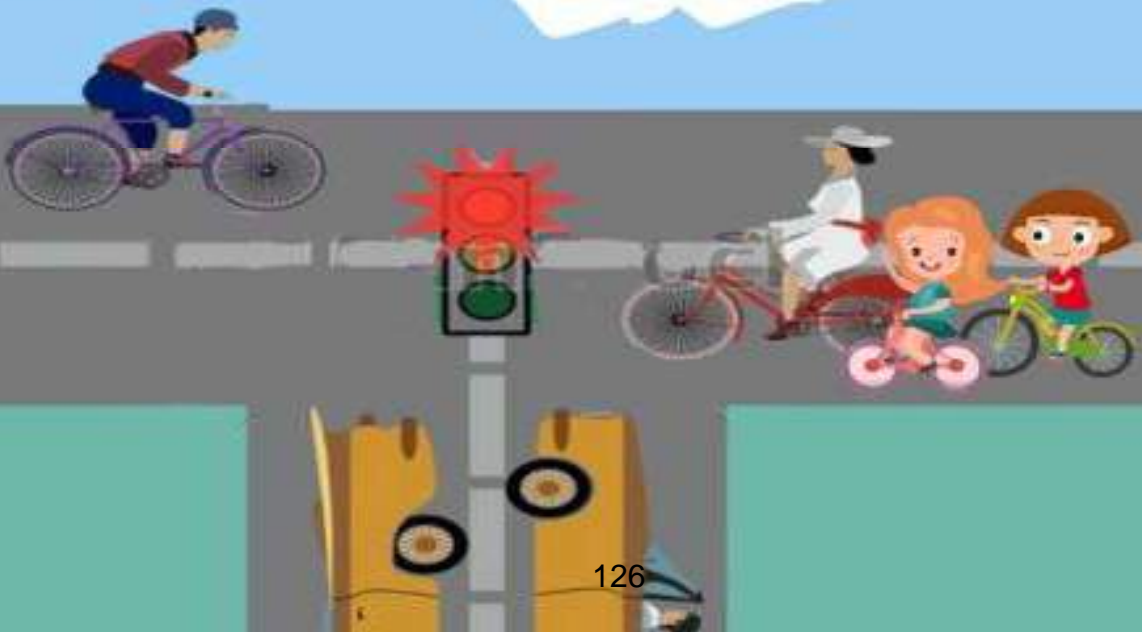
Then, they go cycling to school.

Jerry : “As a doctor, we must punctually work. We also have to do our jobs. Because we have lot responsibilities to help and cure our patients, we must work hard.”

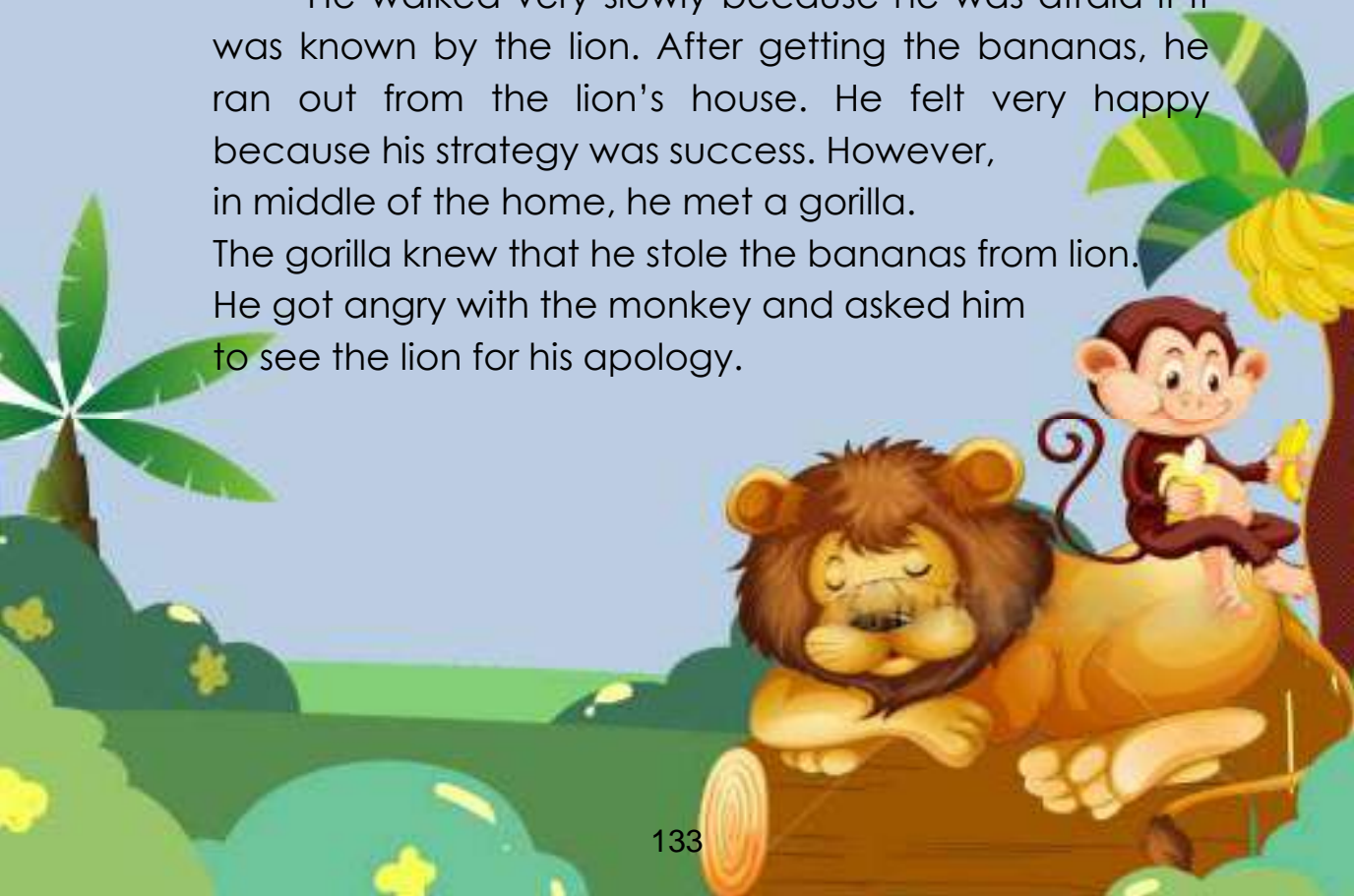


The Monkey and The Lion

A Mousedeer And A Farmer

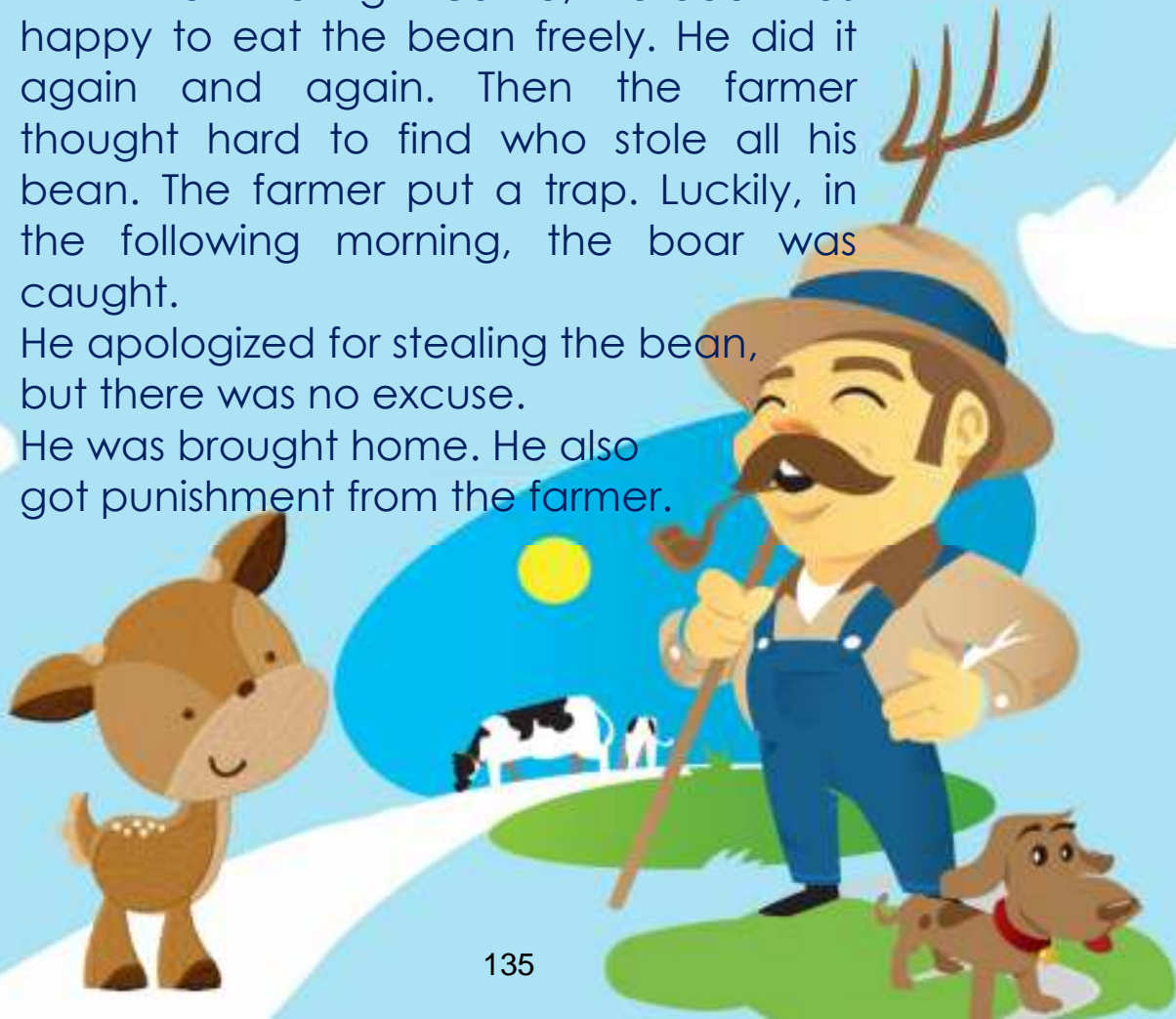

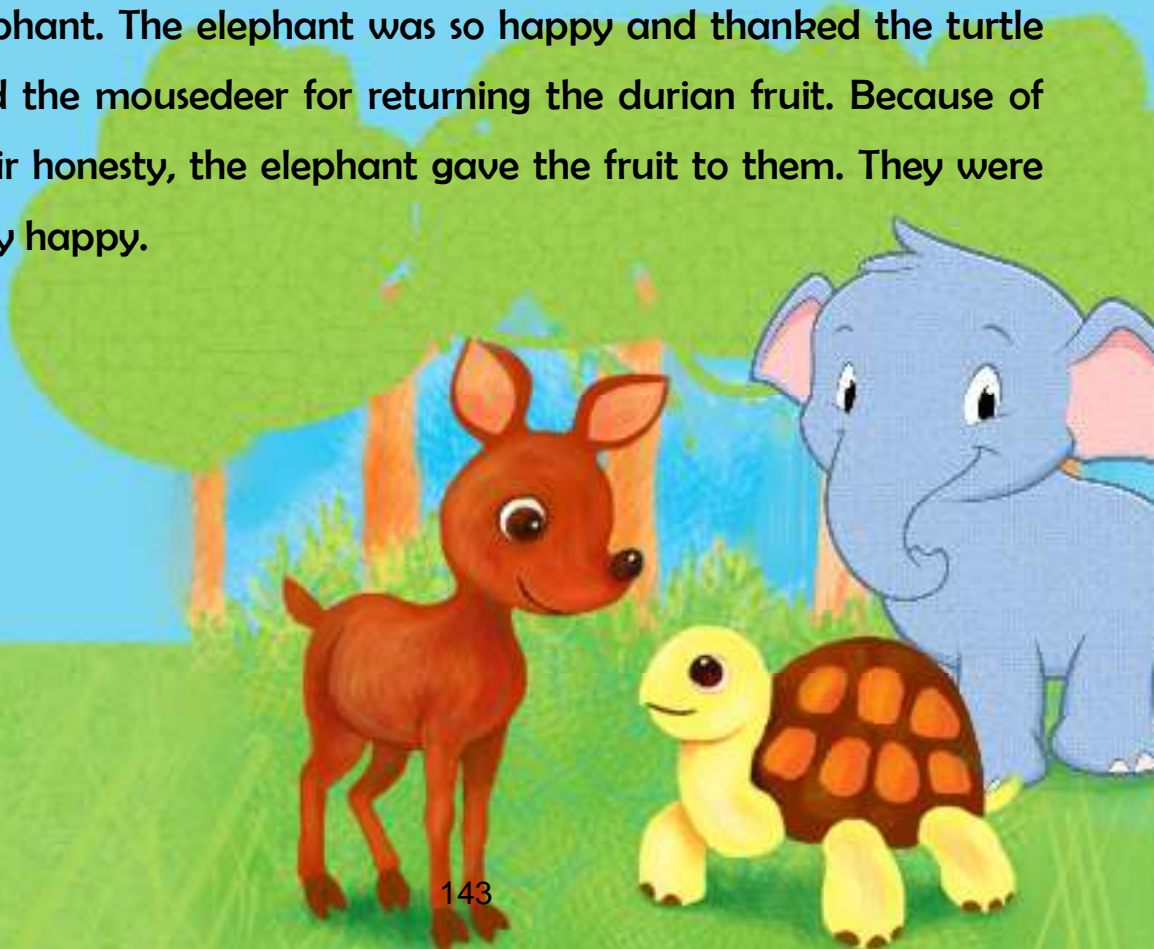

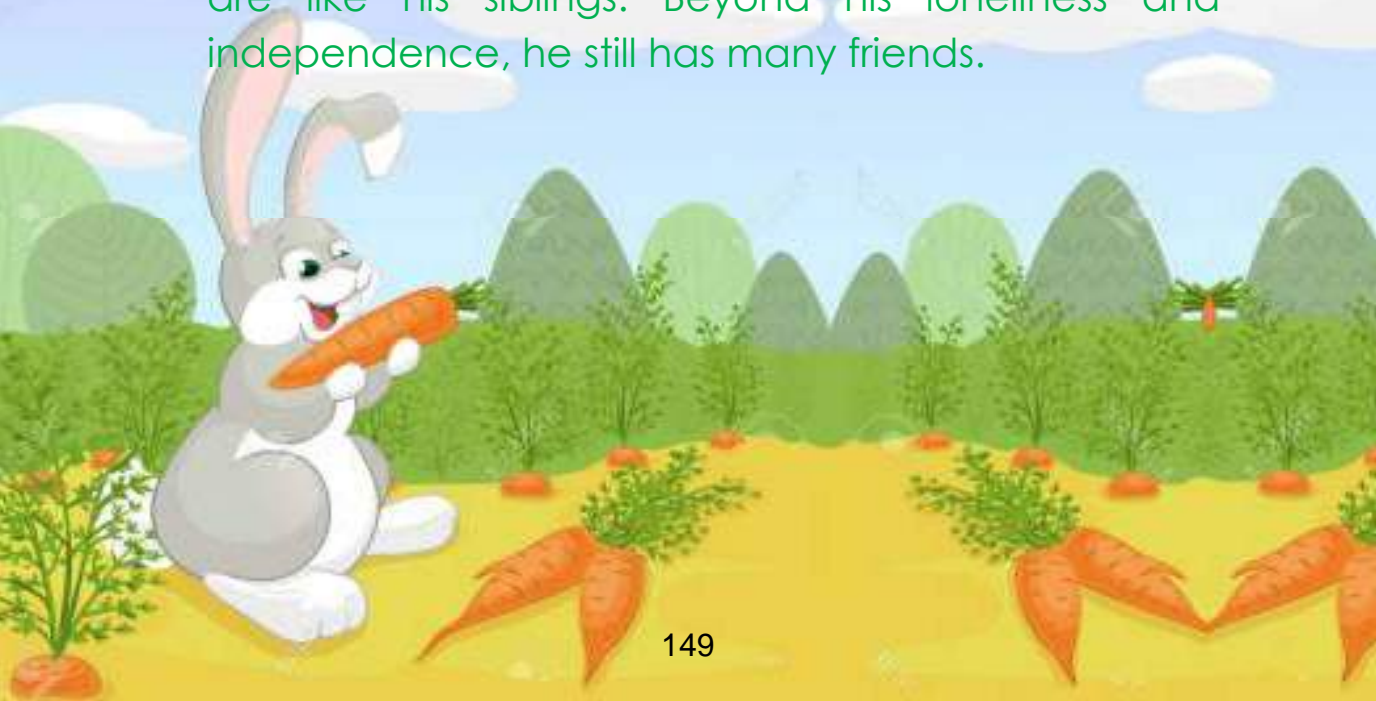
I trust my father and obey him. Then I go to school alone. So, my father does not need to pick me up to school, because I am an independent student.
