CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

This chapter presents the background of the research, statement of research problem, objectives of the research, significance of the research, scope and limitation of the research, and definition of key terms.

A. Background of the Research

Human life always closely related to society, of course there are many values that must be learned to achieve a comfortable and prosperous life. One thing that needs to be learned is moral values. In social life, moral values are used as the determinant of a person's attitude. Moral values can be defined as a term in logic that a principle or action or human character is right or wrong and good or bad views about the good and bad of human actions and character. However, the differences between this research and previous research is to identify types of moral values in the "Up" movie and research methods.
