- 3. Provide more detailed explanation of the research methodology: The abstract should include a more detailed explanation of the research methodology used to analyze M. Syuhudi Ismail's views. Briefly explain how the author applied the descriptive-analytical method and referred to the typology of hadith critics in the science of al-jarh wa altardil
- 4. Use more specific keywords: The presented keywords are still too general. It is recommended to use more specific and representative keywords that reflect the research content, such as "companion justice in hadith criticism" or "M. Syuhudi Ismail's perspective on hadith authenticity."
- 5. Integrate research findings: The abstract should provide a concise overview of the findings from the analysis of M. Syuhudi Ismail's views. Briefly explain the unique contributions brought by this research in expanding our understanding of the justice of companions and its influence on the validity of hadith narrations.
