CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This last chapter presents the conclusion of the research and suggestion dealing with a comparative study on using picture series and cartoon movie toward students' writing achievement in narrative text.

A. Conclusion

After all of data were analyzed on the research result, the researcher can give some conclusion as follow:

- The students' score in writing achievement taught by using picture series
 as media the mean score is 75,32 so the mean score of picture series is
 higher.
- 2. The students' score in writing achievement taught by using cartoon movie as media the mean score is 75,16. It means that the mean score of cartoon movie is higher.
- 3. The result of picture series is better on students' ability in writing narrative text. It is showed by the result score of F_{ratio} is to 5.053 and F_{table} in 5% 2.53. So, F_{ratio} be bigger than F_{table} in both 5% of significance level. It is concluded that the Ha is accepted and Ho is rejected. It means that picture series has higher result on students' writing achievement.

B. Suggestion

Based on the research result, the researcher suggest to:

1. The teacher

The English teacher especially in teaching narrative text in the class are suggested to use picture series and cartoon movie as media because this media are effective to improve students' writing achievement.

2. The students

By using picture series and carton movie as media, it can improve their achievement in writing. The students are suggested to follow up the writing by using the media in their study. The students would be active and independent in classroom. The media help the students become active in learning English. It is hoped that the students can increase and improve their ability in writing. So, the use of media in teaching learning process is important.

3. Future Researcher

For future researcher, this research in picture series and cartoon movie as media can be used as input to conduct the next research with different subject, population and place.
