## **CHAPTER V**

## **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS**

This chapter is devoted to draw some conclusion and suggestions based on the research findings and discussion presented in the previous chapter.

## A. Conclusions

Based on the result of data analysis, some conclusions are drawn as follows:

- 1. The student's ability in speaking before being taught by using Talking Stick Strategy is generally low. It is showed by their gained scores in Pre-Test. There are 14 students (46.7 %) get score between 50-59. Meanwhile, 16 students (53.3 %) get score between 60-69. These two groups of students indicate that their speaking skill needs to be improved.
- 2. The student's ability in speaking after being taught by using Talking Stick Strategy is better than before being taught by using Talking Stick Strategy. It is showed by their gained scores in Post-Test. There are 2 students (6.7%) get score between 50-59. Meanwhile, 22 students (73.3%) get score between 60-69. Another 6 students (20%) gain score between 70-79. Those three groups of students indicate that their speaking skill is in average.
