

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents the conclusion of the study related to the implementation of Five W's Stars Diagram Strategy to Improve students' Ability in Reading Narrative Text at the eighth grade H students at SMPN 1 Sumbergempol in the Academic Year 2015/2016. This part also talks about the suggestions for the teachers, and the other researchers based on the findings on this study.

A. Conclusion

Based on the research findings and conclusion, it is concluded that student's reading ability in narrative text and their involvement in English class could be improved by using Five W's Stars Diagram technique. From the result of the analysis of the research, it was proven that the student score of reading taught by using Five W's Stars Diagram technique in cycle 1 and cycle 2 is better than in preliminary study. In preliminary study there was only 48% of the student who got 75. In cycle 1 72% and then in cycle 2 85%.

Improving Ability in Reading Narrative text achieved is caused by teacher implemented Five W's Stars technique, with some steps of:

- Teachers provide materials/ teaching materials
- Students attention in the classroom

- Student make conclusions with their friends
- The findings in discussing
- Summing up the results
- Asking difficult during teaching learning
- Conclude the material
- Assessment / students worksheet
- test reading

B. Suggestion

Based on the conclusion of the research data, some suggestions are offered deeply to the students, the teachers, and other researchers in order to improve the reading. The suggestions are as follows:

1. For the Teacher

The writer suggests for the English teacher to use this strategy as alternative way in teaching reading to help the students to improve their reading.

2. For the Future Researcher

The researcher hopes that this study will be useful for the future researcher as the reference to make a further research, especially to improve the students' reading.
