

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

Based on the results of the study on the previous chapter, in this chapter the writer would like to draw conclusions and suggestion for the reader.

A. Conclusion

Based on the research results that were described in chapter IV and their interpretation, the researcher draws the following conclusion:

1. Students' understanding in Recount text before being taught by using diary practice is fair in both groups. Their score in pre-test is low than in post-test. It can be seen from their total score in pre-test is 2565 (experimental group) and 2465 (control group).
2. Students' understanding in Recount text after being taught by using diary practice is good in experimental and fair in control group. Their score in post-test is high than in pre-test for experimental group and some of students in control group are good and some of them are fair. It can be seen from their total score in post-test is 2885 (experimental group) and 2420 (control group).
3. From the calculation enclosed, there was a significant difference in the achievement between the students who were taught by using

diary practice and those who did not for the first grade students of MA Terpadu AL-ANWAR in academic year 2015/2016.

B. Suggestion

Based on the whole result of the research, the researcher would like to give the following suggestions:

1. For English teachers try to use diary writing in teaching writing recount text because it has the similar characteristic as recount text. Students can be easier to express their ideas without any pressure.
2. For next researchers, they can use this research as their reference on same field. They are also expected to be able to cover up the limitation of this research and provide more detail information. They may be conducting a research by using the same medium but in different type of text with their own creativity.
