

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the researcher writes the conclusion of overall research result after analyzing the data in the previous chapter. The conclusions are drawn based on the formulated research questions.

A. Conclusions

Based on the research finding and the analysis of the utterances used by the main characters consisting of expressive acts in the movie script *a thousand words* by Steve Koren, the conclusions are drawn as follow:

1. Types of Expressive acts performed in movie *a thousand words* by Steve Koren

Based on the analysis of the movie script *a thousand works* by Steve Koren, there are six types of expressive acts used by main characters found in the movie script. They were thanking, apologizing, congratulating, welcoming, liking, and disliking.

The researcher found at least 93 utterances consist of expressive acts. 22 expressions of thank, 18 expressions of apology, 3 expressions of congratulation, 11 expressions of welcome, 24 expressions of like, 15 expressions of dislike.

2. The formal pattern of the expressive actrealization performed in movie

a thousand words

The researcher presented the conclusion of formal pattern in expressive acts found in *a thousand words* movie in the sub-division for each type of expressive acts.

- a. Formal patterns of expressive acts in thanking are declarative, imperative interrogative, and exclamation.
- b. Formal patterns of expressive acts in apologizing are declarative and exclamation.
- c. Formal patterns of expressive acts in congratulating are declarative and exclamation.
- d. Formal patterns of expressive acts in welcoming are declarative, imperative, interrogative, and exclamation.
- e. Formal patterns of expressive acts in like are declarative, imperative, interrogative, and exclamation.
- f. Formal patterns of expressive act in dislike are declarative, imperative, interrogative, and exclamation.

3. The frequency of each type of expressive acts found in *a thousand words*

The frequency of each type of expressive acts was:

23,7% for thanking acts, 19,3% for apologizing acts, 3,2% for congratulating acts, 11,8% for welcoming acts, 25,8% for like acts, and 16,2% for dislike acts.

B. Suggestions

After getting the results of the analysis, the researcher would like to give some suggestions as teaching and learning consideration, which are important for the students and the next researchers.

1. Suggestion for the students

- a. The students should learn English because it is important to increase their knowledge.
- b. The students should know what pragmatics is. By studying pragmatics, the students know how to use pragmatics in their conversation.
- c. The student should know how to express the expressive acts in their daily life. This study can help the students get the examples of expressive acts from the native speaker in the movie.

2. Suggestion for the next researcher

The future research can conduct the similar research, but in different subject. The next researcher can use novel or advertisement in the television that similar with this topic. The next researcher are also

suggested to have the same study but in different subject because this study is still rarely analyzed.
