CHAPTER V

DISCUSSION

In this chapter the researcher presents the discussion of the research that have interpreted by the researcher related to the finding.

After analyzing the data, the researcher has presented a discussion about findings to answer the research problems. The first research problem focused on the politeness strategy used by the character in *I*, *Robot* movie performing requesting and ordering, the researcher found a politeness strategies includes bald on record with sub-strategy cases of non-minimization of the face treat and cases of FTA-oriented bald-on-record usage were 14 utterances.

The second research problems was concerning to suggesting and advising the researcher found a politeness strategy includes bald on with sub-strategy sympathetic advice or warnings were 5 utterances.

Bald on record was kinds of politeness which often used *I*, *Robot* movie. It caused by all of the characters mostly employed bald on-record to realize his/her request and ordering. These findings also was supported by the theory provided by Brown and Levinson (1987: 95) "the prime reason for bald on record usage may be sated simply: in general whenever S wants to do the FTA with maximum efficiency more than he wants satisfy H's face, even to any degree, he will choose the bald on record strategy." Brown and Levinson (1987: 73) Bald on record is a direct politeness strategy which contains no repressive particle to soften the Face Threatening Act (FTA).

Then in this research, the researcher also concluded that the characters in *I*, *Robot* movie mostly used bald on record in request and ordering. Brown and levinson (1978:70) stated "Speech acts which are inherently FTAs include requesting, disagreeing, contradicting, criticizing, advising, and questioning".
