## CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the researcher arrives at the conclusion after analyzing and interpreting at the obtained data in the previous chapter. The conclusion drawn based on the formulated research question, while suggestion is intended to give more information to the next researcher who are interested in doing similar research.

## A. Conclusions

- Types of language function are found in the Miracle Worker Movie, are:
  - a. Expressive function appeared on 21 utterances that is 27%.
  - b. Directive function appeared on 27 utterances that is 34%.
  - c. Referential function appeared on 11 utterances that is 14%.
  - d. Metalinguistic function appeared 4 utterances that is 5%.
  - e. Poetic function appeared 11 utterances that is 14%.
  - f. Phatic function appeared 5 utterances that is 6%.

The total number of the utterances which contain language function of the conversational fragment found in the Miracle Worker Movie is 79 utterances.

- 2. Language function formally realized:
  - a. Expressive function classified into 17 utterances 81% as declarative sentences, 3 utterances 14% as imperative sentences, 1 utterances 5% as interrogative sentences.
  - b. Directive function classified into 18 utterances 67% as imperative sentences, 8 utterances 30% as declarative sentences, and 1 utterances 3% as interrogative sentences.
  - c. Referential function classified into 11 utterances 100% containing interrogative sentences.
  - Metalinguistic function classified into 2 utterances 50% as declarative sentences and 2 utterances 50% as interrogative sentences.
  - e. Poetic function classified into 11 utterances 100% containing declarative sentences.
  - f. Phatic function classified into 3 utterances 60% as declarative sentences and 2 utterances 40% as imperative sentences.
- 3. The frequency of each types of language function found in the conversational fragment of Miracle Worker Movie.
  - a. 27% for expressive function.
  - b. 34% for directive function.
  - c. 14% for referential function.
  - d. 5% for metalinguistic function.
  - e. 14% for poetic function.

f. 6% for phatic function.

## **B.** Suggestion

After getting the result of analysis, the researcher would like to give some suggestion as consideration which is important for the students and the next researcher.

- 1. The suggestion for the students
  - a. The students should realize that English is important to study. Studying English could increase their knowledge about how to use English appropriately.

- b. The students should know pragmatics in order to makes their utterances make sense and acceptable. By studying pragmatics, the students will know how to use language in conversation well.
- c. The students should know how to apply in daily life especially in using language based on its function. They can observe further about types of language function that can be used in interpreting the utterances, so they can apply and pay attention with context in their utterances before addressed.
- 2. The suggestion for the next researcher

The future research can conduct the research with the same topic but in different subjects. So, it can give more complete information for the subject. The next researcher can use the students in junior high school, senior high school, or in both of them. It might result in different results because of cultural differences.
