

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

After analyzing the data in chapter IV, the next chapter is conclusion and suggestion. This is the last part of the research about assertive and directive acts in “My Name is Khan” movie. The conclusion is taken based on the findings and analysis that is done by the researcher. It is used to answer the research questions.

A. Conclusion

Based on the research finding and the analysis about utterances that is used by the two main characters of “My Name is Khan” movie in the chapter IV, the conclusions are:

1. **Types of assertive acts performed by the two main characters in “My Name is Khan” movie**

Based on the first problem “what types of assertive act acts are performed by the two main characters in My Name is Khan movie?”, the researcher conclude that there are five types of assertive act in that movie, they are:

a. Asserting act

It is used by speaker to convince the listener that their statement is true. The researcher found forty three data contains of asserting act. For the example: *“My name is Khan, and I’m not a terrorist.”*

b. Concluding act

It is used to state about conclusion or judgment of something. The researcher found six data containing that act. For example: *“President will change. I have to meet him before that. Now, I need to meet him now”*.

c. Describing act

It is used to give the details information about person, thing or event. Based on the findings, the researcher found twelve data belongs to describing act. For example: *“This cream has an extra care skin nourishing lotion which contains Aloe Vera,...”*.

d. Assessing act

It has function to predict something. The researcher found four data that is classified as assessing act. For example: *“One minute, and Oh, no, no not one minute. It will take longer than one minute”*.

e. Complaining act

It express about speaker’s disappointment of something. The researcher found three data contains of that act. For example: *“I don't accept that. I do not accept that. There has to be an answer. And if you can't find it, I will”*.

From the result of data above, the researcher concludes that asserting act is the most often appears than other acts. Moreover, the most rarely appears is complaining which contains of three data.

2. Types of directive acts performed by the two main characters in “My Name is Khan” movie

Based on the data which was analyzed by using Searle and Yule’s theory, the researcher found four types of directive act in “My Name is Khan” movie. Those data such as:

a. Advising act

It is used to give opinion or advice other people about something. The researcher found six data that belongs to advising act. An example: *“Ammi, you should sleep now. Sleeping calms the mind”*.

b. Ordering act

It is used to commands someone to do something for the speaker. The researcher found sixteen data that is classified as ordering act. An example: *“Hey, you guys, just leave him alone. Stop it!”*.

c. Requesting act

It is used to express a politeness or asking for something officially. This research contains of nineteen data about requesting act. For example: *“Take me with you, Mandira. Please”*.

d. Suggesting act

It is used to mention an idea, possible plan, or action for other people to be considered. The researcher found six data that can be categorized as suggesting act. An example: *“All our products expire in three months. It dies. You need only four. The rest will get spoilt”*.

Based on the data above, the researcher concludes that requesting act is the most often used by the main characters. It appears nineteen times. Meanwhile the most rarely appears is advising and suggesting. Both of them are appears in six times.

In conclusion, there are many utterances that are classified as assertive and directive acts in “My Name is Khan” movie. It means that assertive and directive acts are cannot be separated in communication. People often used those acts to express their intention in daily conversation also in the movie.

B. Suggestion

After the researcher gets the result of analysis, she wants to give some suggestion as considerations. The researcher hopes that this suggestion will be useful for the learner and the next researcher as follow:

1. For the learners
 - a. The learners should realize that English is important to be studied. Because of that, it will be better if learn English from many sources. Learn English not always from the book material, but can also from movie.
 - b. The researcher suggests for the learner to study about pragmatic especially illocutionary act. It will help learners to know about speaker’s intended meaning in communication. So, it can reduce misunderstanding between speaker and listener.

2. For the next researcher

For the next researcher who want to analyze about speech act especially illocutionary act, this research can be used as references. They can conduct similar research but using different subject. The researcher suggests them to be more creative. Finally, the researcher hopes that this research will be useful for English learners.
