

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the researcher presents conclusions and suggestions. In conclusion, the answers of the research problem are represented by the researcher in brief. And in the suggestion, the researcher gives suggestions and recommendation to the readers, students and other researchers.

A. Conclusion

In this section, the researcher makes the conclusions after reading and identifying Figurative Language in the lyrics of Maher Zain selected songs. In the findings of this research, the researcher can classify the findings into two main points. The first, the researcher found eight kinds of figurative language in the Maher Zain selected songs. They are simile, metaphor, hyperbole, personification, repetition, and rhetoric. Hyperbole is figurative language that mostly appears in this songs. It means that these songs likes to intensify the utterances, expression or actions.

The second activity in analyzing the frequency of occurrences of each type of Figurative Language, which result in the finding as follow: The researcher found 1 similes. Than in metaphor the researcher found 4 occurrences. The next type is hyperbole there are 12 occurrences of hyperbole in these songs. Hyperbole is the most frequently used in song lyrics of Maher Zain. The researcher found 6 personification in song lyrics of Maher Zain.

The researcher found 9 repetition in these songs, and found 5 rhetoric. It means that the most appearance type of figurative language is hyperbole. Meanwhile, the most rarely appearance of type figurative language is simile.

A. Suggestions

After getting the results of analysis, the researcher would like to give some suggestions as teaching learning considerations which are important for the students and the next researcher.

1. Suggestion for the students

Studying English can be done through studying literature. The students should know about English literature to facilitate them to express ideas, or thoughts. Studying English literature gives the reader information, knowledge, experience, and pleasure. The students should learn in understand and appreciate literally works. By appreciating the literally work it can grow a good attitude, for example for appreciating other human.

2. Suggestion for the future research

The future researcher can use the results of the present study as a reference to conduct a further study related to figurative language because this research explained about figurative language that found in songs lyric, and still there are many kinds of figurative language can be found in other than songs lyric which need to be analysis.
