CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter explains about conclusion and suggestion based on data analysis in previous chapter.

A. Conclusion

Some conclusion that could be drawn from the explanation in the previous chapter, those are:

- The students' achievement in reading comprehension who taught by using Tea Party strategy was better than students who taught without using Tea Party strategy. It can be seen from the mean score of students who taught by using Tea Party is 70,71. The highest score is 100 and the lowest score is 50.
- 2. The students' achievement in reading comprehension who taught without using Tea Party strategy less than students who taught by using Tea Party strategy. It can be seen from the mean score of students who taught without using Tea Party is 53,18. The highest score is 95 and the lowest score is 25.
- 3. After all of data were analyzed on the research result in SPSS, the output Independent Samples T-test showed that the significance (2-tailed) smaller than significance level (0,001<0,05) and the null hypothesis (Ho) is rejected. So, there is significant different of students' achievement in reading comprehension taught by using tea party strategy for the eight

grade students of MTs Sultan Agung Jabalsari Sumbergempol Tulungagung in the academic year of 2017/2018.

B. Suggestion

There are some suggestions related to the result of this research.

1. For the English Teacher

The researcher hopes that Tea Party Strategy can useful for English teacher when they teach reading comprehension. So, it will be increase the teacher's ability in the teaching – learning process.

2. For the English Students

The researcher hopes that Tea Party Strategy can useful for the student English department when they teach their students in the future to have a mutual cooperation with another student. They can stimulate the students to increase their reading ability in reading comprehension.

3. For the Next Researchers

The result of this research can be used as a reference for those who want to conduct a research related Tea Party Strategy. The next researcher can cover up the limitation or disadvantage of this research and provide more detail information.
