CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of Study

Language restrictions will become a barrier to understanding the lessons and creating quality academic output. Apart from the limitations of language, having to live in an unfamiliar environment and experiencing cultural differences that are unattainable can lead to a phenomenon called culture "shock or cultural shock". The panic and confusion in the midst of new societies and cultures is another situation where each person has different ways of dealing with each other. There are some students who cannot adapt to the way they live, making it difficult to live in a foreign country. For instance, having limited vocabulary, cannot decode word while reading, do not understand in listening to, written incorrect grammatical, speaking English is not fluent and so forth.

F. Definition of the Key Terms

To make study clearer to the readers and avoid confusion in understanding this study, the researcher would like to explain several definitions of key terms:

1. Learning

Learning is a process, of both humans and animals can be seen. In a simple learning a process of living things is won their behavior based on the experiences change. It is also expressed by *Gage* (1984), stating that learning is a process in which an organism changes its behavior as a result of experience. Learn Experience in the life of a person to do something, or take an action premised is, is a result of the learning process. In this research, the learning is the process of gaining knowledge and expertise about learning English.

2. Problem

Problem refers to issues that are obstacles, difficulties, resistance, or challenges or any situation that requires a solution. In this research problem is any difficulty, obstacle, challenges in learning English toward Thai students at English Department of IAIN Tulungagung.

3. International student

International students are "transient visitors" to new and different academic communities and are increasingly a feature of the social, cultural and academic life of many countries (Montgomery, 2010). International students refer to Thai students at English Department of IAIN Tulungagung.

4. Learning Strategy

Oxford (1990) defined learning strategies as "specific action taken by the learner to make learning easier, faster, more, more enjoyable, more self-directed, more effective, and transferable to new situation". In this study, Learning Strategy refers to Language Learning Strategy that the students use to deal with their problem in learning English.
