

CHAPTER VI

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents the conclusion and suggestion dealing with the finding and discussion as presented in the previous chapter of the research.

A. CONCLUSION

Concerning with the result of the finding and discussion of the study, it can be concluded that (a) English OTC facilitate many kind of activities to improve the students' speaking ability; (b) The activities of English OTC are contributive to the students' speaking ability improvement.

Those activities are speech, debate, story telling, drilling, and reading aloud. The students were drilled a lot of speaking practices. The students conducted some preparation before speaking practices. It helped the students to get successful in the speaking practices.

The teachers as a tutor in English OTC that facilitated a lot of activities stated that those activities gave good effect to the students' speaking ability improvement. All of the member also stated that they got benefit from English OTC's activities.

Meanwhile, all of the members stated that a lot of speaking practices could improved some aspects that are contributive to build up the students' self confidence, increasing of grammar mastery, increasing of vocabularies mastery, increasing of pronunciation ability, increasing of fluently and increasing of the ability to organize ideas fast.

Drilling with many kind of activities were build up the students' self confidence. Consequently, they were accustomed to speak up in front of people. A lot of practices were reduced their anxiety during speaking in front of public. Then, they were try to speak naturally.

English OTC's activities is also contributive to the students' speaking ability improvement in term of the incresing on their grammar mastery, vocabularies mastery and pronunciation ability. In this community the students also get theory of grammar. Then, the students get a chance to apply grammar in an appropriate context. The students believe that their grammar mastery get increased, because they are always drilled with a lot of speaking practices.

The students' vocabularies mastery get increased because they always get new vocabularies from the material that they have read. Beside that, they get new vocabularies from their tutors' explanation and their friends' performance. In addition, the students' pronunciation ability also get increased because the tutors always drill them to pronounce words clearly and give correction to the students' pronunciation which is supported by giving sufficient examples.

Meanwhile, speak naturally mean that the students were able to speak without hesitation. The students also said that after joining English OTC's activities they can speak fluently. Beside that, the students accustomed to organizing ideas fast while speaking. The ability to organizing ideas fast is important for the students.

B. SUGGESTIONS

Based on the result of research findings, the writer would like to give some suggestions:

1. For The Teacher

From knowing the contribution of English OTC's activities that explaining by the students, the teachers are expected to understand the students' needs to improve the students' speaking ability. In this case, the teacher must make the activities as interesting as possible to improve the students' speaking ability. It is use to make the students will not get bored in conducting speaking practices. In addition, the teacher can modify or add the activities to facilitate the students to do more English practices.

2. For The Students

For students, the students as the member of English OTC should pay attention to the teacher explanation and instruction during conducting speaking activities. They will get a successful in speaking practices if they do a lot of practices.

3. For The Other Researcher

The suggestion for other researchers who want conduct the similar research related to the contribution of English community or English OTC toward to the improvement of the students' speaking ability, the result of this research can be used as additional reference. It is use to make the future research better.
