## **CHAPTER I**

## **INTRODUCTION**

# A. Background of The Research

Ecless, et.al, (2003:10) argues the importance of extracurricular activities for youths. Such activities can provide opportunities: (a) to acquire and practice specific social, physical and intellectual skills that may be useful in wide variety of setting including school; (b) to contribute to the well being of one's community and to develop a sense of agency as a member of one's community; (c) to belong to socially recognized and valued group; (d) to established supportive social networks of peers and adults can help in both the present and the future; and (e) to experience and deal with challenge. In the other words, extracurricular activities are the place when pupils can exercise the skills, especially the social and emotional skills to face the real problems in the society.

Educators have designed school experiences to aid both academic and non-academic successes in school age children. Reading, writing, and other indispensable academic skills are related to learning about self communicating and working well with others and gaining broader understanding of cultural influences. Furthermore, social competence in childhood often is cited as a predictor of academic achievement. Oliver also states that individual's participation in extracurricular activities can build young persons' interests in school, strengthen their sense of identity, and allow them greater exposure and self-satisfaction.

Many studies have been conducted into the implications of extracurricular involvement. These studies mostly look at the nature of the activity, the background of the students to establish the effect of participation in activities offered. Outcomes of studies have indicated that involvement in these activities can be beneficial towards the motivation of

student, college education, and grade levels, personal and interpersonal skills among others. A number of these studies will be addressed to provide an overview of the impact of extracurricular activities on those who participate.

Students who participate in extracurricular activities generally benefit from many opportunities they can do. Benefits of participating in extracurricular activities included having better grades, having higher scores and higher educational attainment, attending school more regularly, and having a higher self-concept. Participants in out-of-school activities often learn skills such as teamwork and leadership. Those who participate in out-of-school activities often have higher grade point averages, a decrease in absenteeism, and an increased connection to the school.

The active participation of students in extracurricular has strong connection with their interest. The students will be involved if they have interest to join extracurricular. It happens because the students are happy toward the program applied in extracurricular. By engaging in extracurricular activities, students may be required to maintain good grades.
