

CHAPTER IV

FINDING AND ANALYSIS

This is the main part of the whole research. In this chapter, the writer presents finding of the research that found by the writer himself. This finding are very important because the finding as the data presentation.

A. The Expressive Act in “the Fate of the Furious” Movie

In the study of speech act, the utterance can distinguished into three part, locutionary, illocutionary, and perlocutionary. When the speakers say something about what they feel like “Nice!”, “I’m sorry”, or “great!” they actually are performing expressive speech acts. According to Searle (2005), The illocutionary point of this class is to express the psychological state specified in the sincerity condition about a state of affairs specified in the propositional content. The paradigms of expressive verbs are "thank", "congratulate" ^ "apologize", "condole", "deplore", and "welcome". According to Yule (1996), they may express pleasure, pain, likes, dislikes, joy, or sorrow. Best on the statement above, the researcher realize that the expressive act are showed the expression of thanking, apologizing, congratulating, condoling, deploring, welcoming, pleasure, like, dislike, pain, joy, and sorrow. So, in this subchapter the writer would like to present the expressive act in “The Fate of The

Furious” movie best on the expression that showed above. The expressive acts are as follow:

1. Apologizing

There are many expression of apologizing that found in the movie. The researcher will present the dialogue that contains the expression apologizing bellow.

Raldo : A deal's a deal. You own my car. And you earn my respect.

Dom : Keep your car. Your respect is good enough for me.

Analysis

Letty were try to escape from there because that is not good situation. They can be killed if they still in there. Letty are didn't like the situation that trapped her. The word that showed the expression of dislike is “**Not good**”.

Syntactical realization

The syntactical realization of that word is declarative. From the analysis above, the researcher was thought that the word is used to make statement. The word that used to make statement is declarative. That's why the researcher analyze the syntactical realization of that word in the text is declarative.

9. Sorrow

There are many expression of sorrow that found in the movie. The researcher will present the dialogue that contains the expression sorrow bellow.

Dom : First time I saw my son was behind a bulletproof glass.

When he reached me, I couldn't hold on.

It's the worst pain I ever felt. I know you know exactly how that feels.

Maybe we could change that.

Magdalene Shaw : I think, You are about to suggest something really dodgy Mr Toretto.

Dom : It's why I'm here.

Analysis

In the dialogue above, the expression of sorrow showed by Dom the dialogue “**It's the worst pain I ever felt**”. In this part, Dom came in the Deckard mother, Magdalene Shaw to asking for help. He was telling her that his son was kidnapped by someone and laid him in the bulletproof glass. He said that he can't hold his son's hand when he reached to him. That situation makes Dom unhappy and pain. The word that showed the expression of sorrow is “**Worst pain**”.

Syntactical realization

The syntactical realization of that word is declarative. From the analysis above, the researcher was thought that the word is used to make statement. The word that used to make statement is declarative. That's why the researcher analyze the syntactical realization of that word in the text is declarative.

The researcher also found the utterance of praising in the other dialogue

Little Nobody : He's got an EMP and nuclear launch codes.

I don't know what it is, but they're building towards something.

Hoobs : Deckard?

Little Nobody : **He didn't make it.**

Analysis

In the dialogue above, the expression of sorrow showed by Hoobs the dialogue “**He didn't make it**”. In this part, Hoobs and team was try to defeat Dom when he will stool the nuke code. In the battle, Deckard was shoot by Dom and Hoobs see that. When they were back into the base, Hoobs ask to Little Nobody about Deckard, he said that Deckard didn't make it. All of team and especially Hoobs feel bad. The sentence “**He didn't make it**” showed the expression of sorrow.

Syntactical realization

The syntactical realization of that word is declarative. From the analysis above, the researcher was thought that the word is used to make statement. The word that used to

make statement is declarative. That's why the researcher analyze the syntactical realization of that word in the text is declarative.

In the other depiction on this movie, this dialogue can show the utterance of thankin.

Deckard : There's no way I'm using Owen, alright? He's a lost cause.

Magdalene Shaw : He's your brother, Deck. He's my son. He's our family.

And our family that died...Bloody shit happening.

You lied about, I mean, I can't believe you.

You've gotten upset, you really upset your mother. Call yourself a brother?

Deckard : Look, I'm in, mum. Ok.

Analysis

In the dialogue above, the expression of sorrow showed by Magdalene Shaw the dialogue “**You've gotten upset, you really upset your mother**”. In this part, Deckard mother were ask him to help Dom and he has to go with Owen, his brother. Deckard don't want to get Owen into this. He said that Owen is a lost cause. Hear that statement, his mother feel upset because he just underestimated his brother. The word “**Upset**” showed the expression of sorrow.

Syntactical realization

The syntactical realization of that word is declarative. From the analysis above, the researcher was thought that the word is used to make statement. The word that used to make statement is declarative. That's why the researcher analyze the syntactical realization of that word in the text is declarative.

C. DISCUSSION

In this chapter, the researcher will discuss about the whole data that gathered to answer the research problem about the expressive speech act and the syntactical realization of the Fate of the Furious movie script. Based on the data that was got by researcher in chapter 4, the researcher was found that the praising expression appears

more than another expression. From the 57 data that was found by researcher about expressive speech act, the 13 of them or in percentage are 22.8 % was praising expression. It means that the praising expressions were the most often appear in the Fate of the Furious movie script.

The praising expressions appear 13 times in this study. The most often appear of the data that were got by researcher were praising expression. Praising expression appear for many times because the story tell about the man named Domonic Toretto called Dom was the man that has a smart, brave, and full of surprise action that showed in this movie. In this movie also took in the many places that can surprise the audience because it took in many secret and famous place just like ex military base in Russia, Cuba beach, Interpol office, city of New York, the agency garage that full of beautiful sports car, etc. In this movie also showed the advanced technology that used by the actor just like God's eye that can use to find anybody around the world by using camera from anywhere in the world.

The study about speech act conducted by Nur Azny Wardani (2011) in Prince of Persia : the Sand of Time, the researcher find any dialogues that are consist of expressive speech act. The expressive speech act form Prince of Persia : the Sand of Time is indirectly express feeling the speaker. In this study the researcher find 57 expressive speech acts from the Fate of the Furious movie script. The expressions are divided into nine categories that are apologizing, thanking, praising, blaming, welcoming, pleasure, like, dislike, and sorrow. The expressions of that are found by researcher also express the feeling of speaker indirectly.
